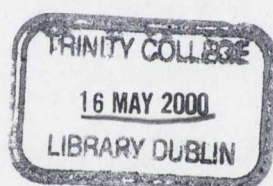

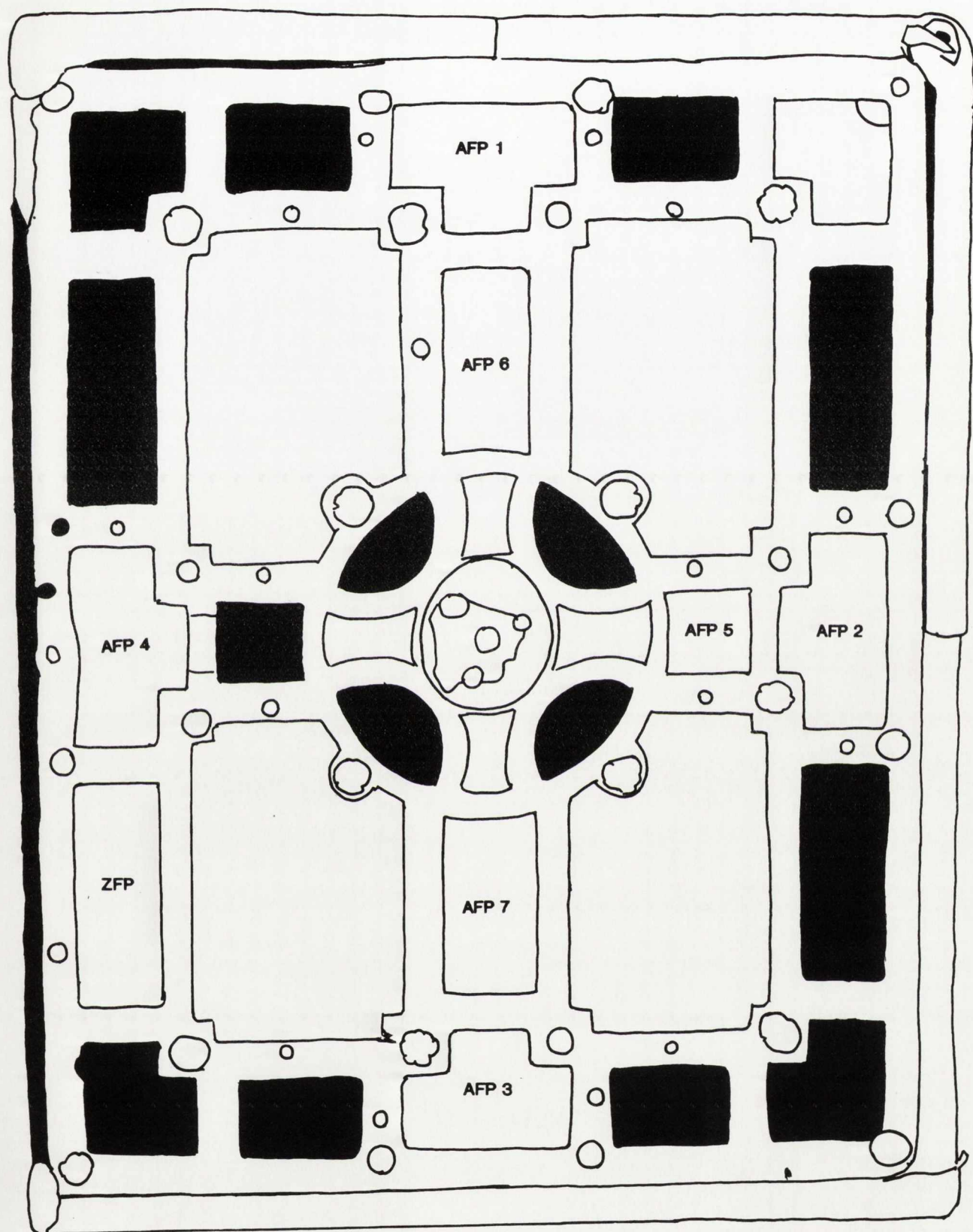
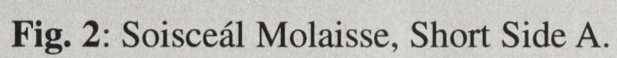


Fig. 1: Soisceál Molaisse, Front.



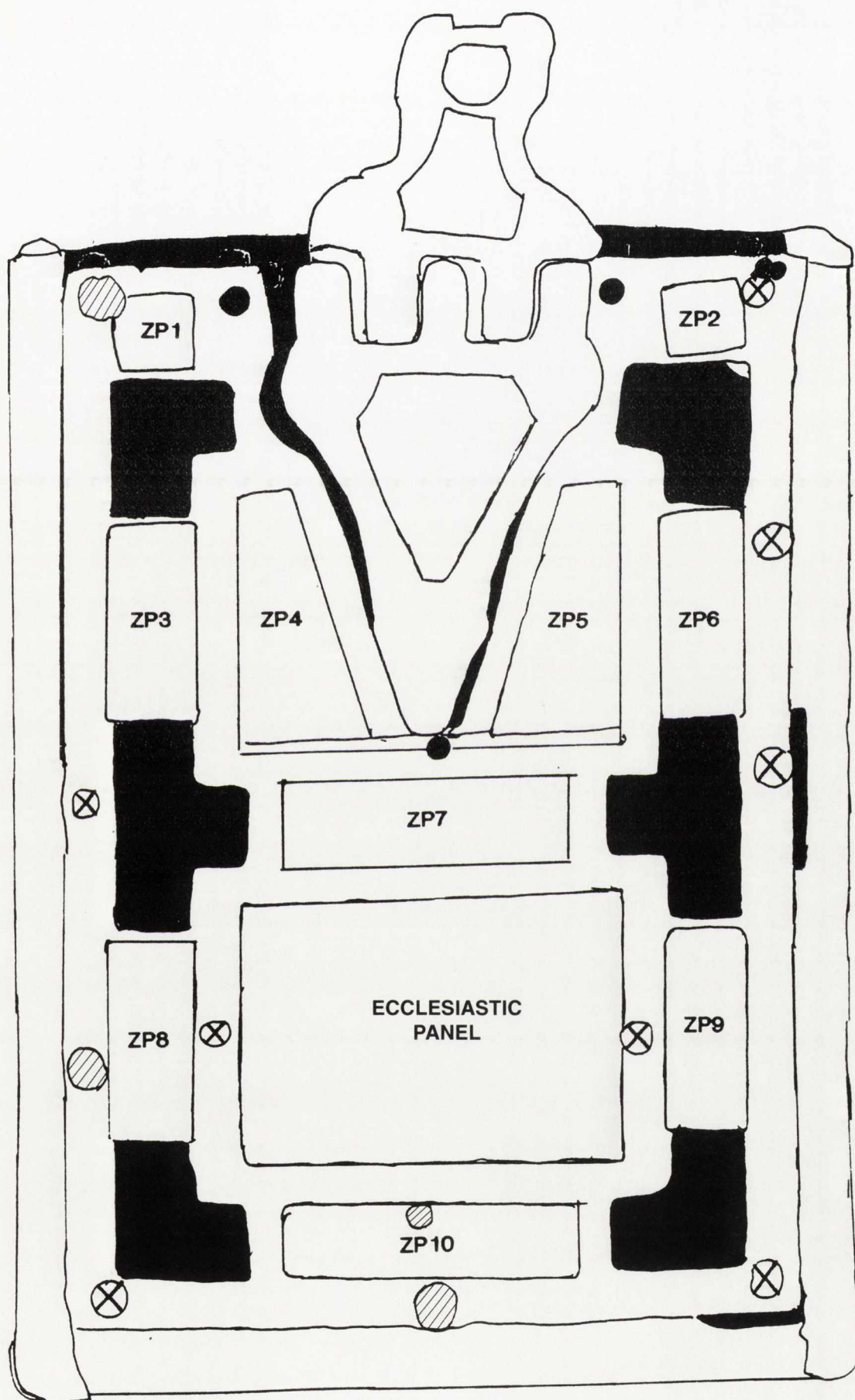


Fig. 3: Soisceál Molaise, Short Side B.

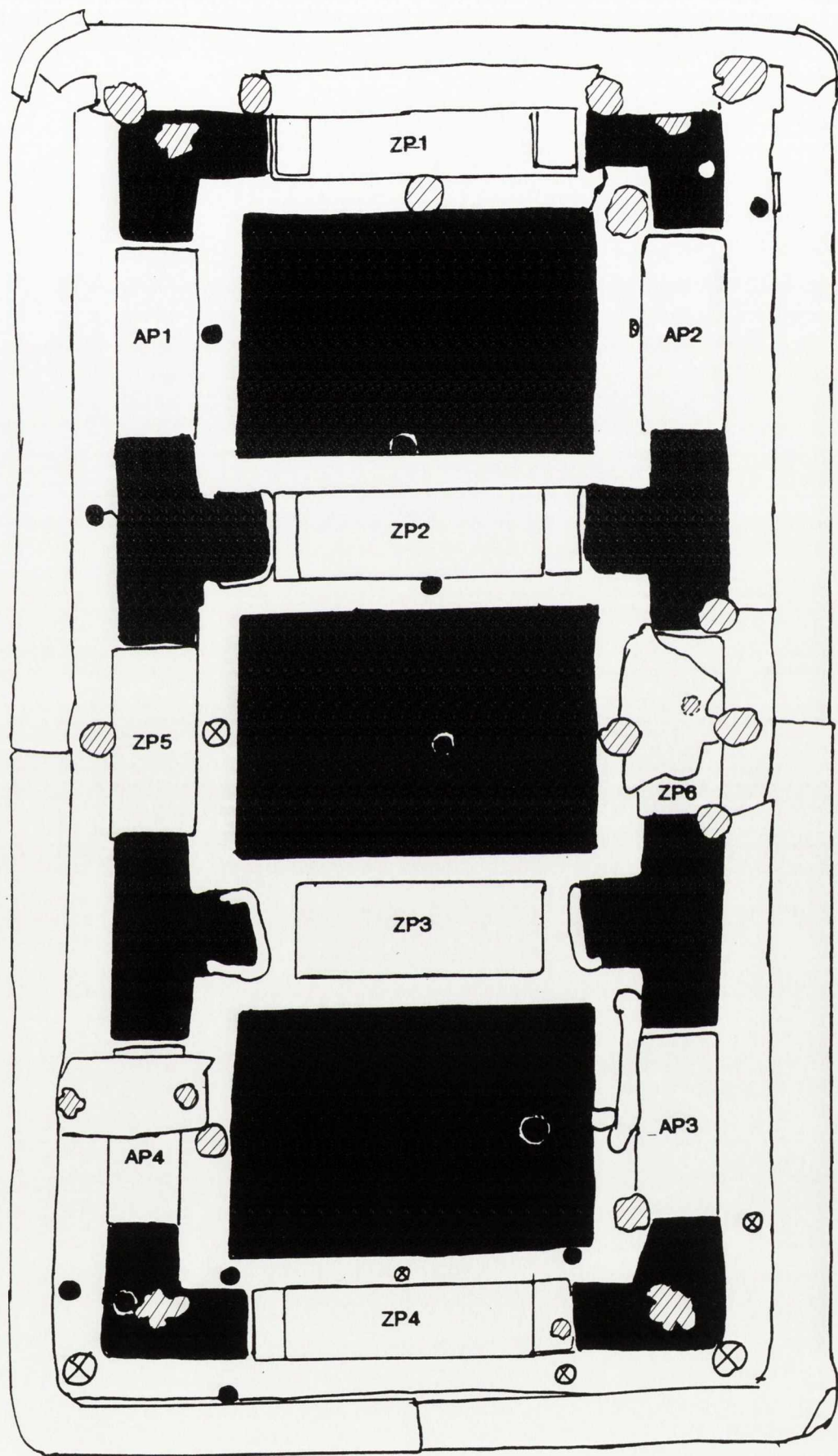


Fig. 4: Soisceál Molaise, Long Side.

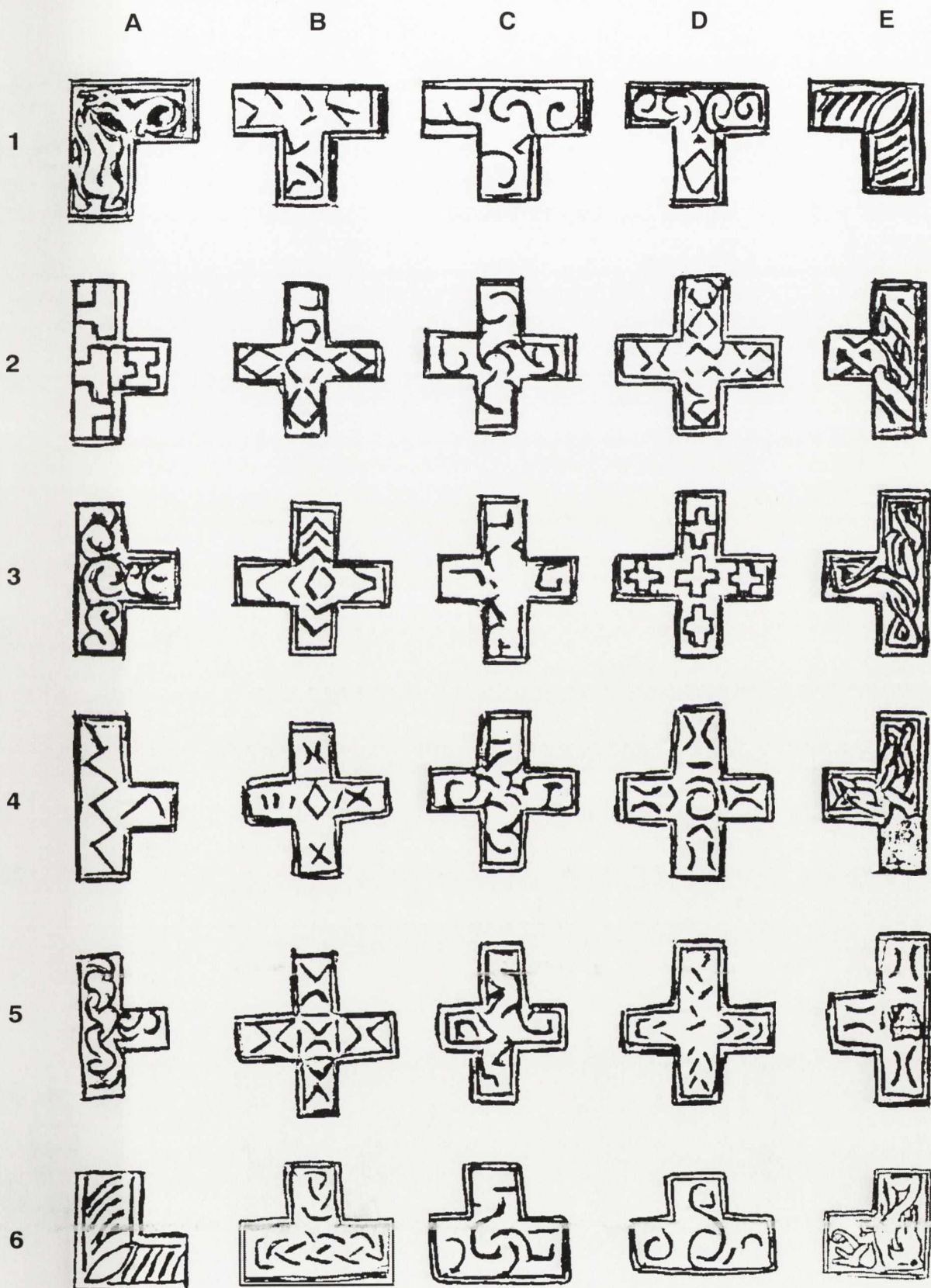


Fig. 5: Soisceál Molaisse, diagram of decorated base plate.

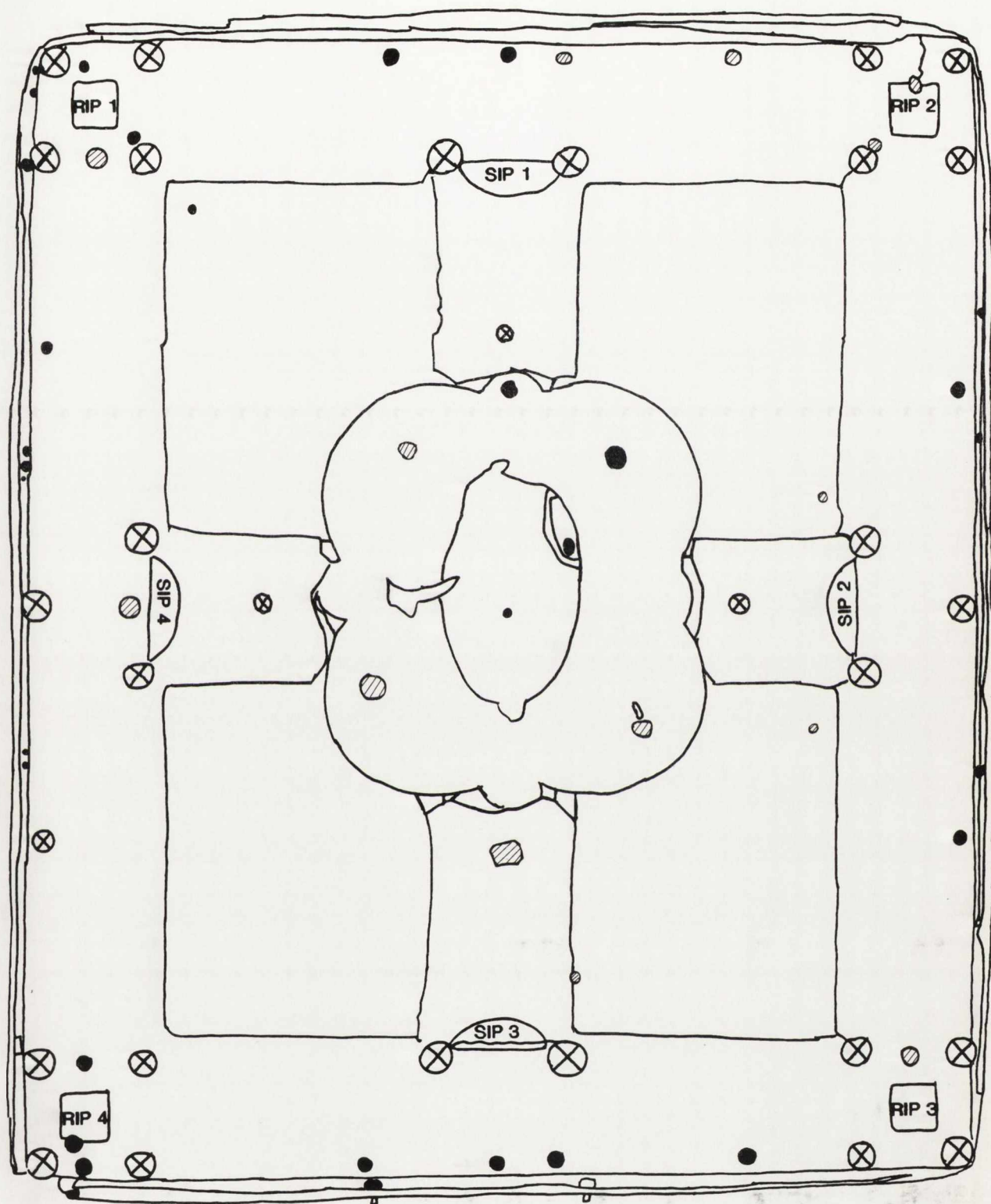
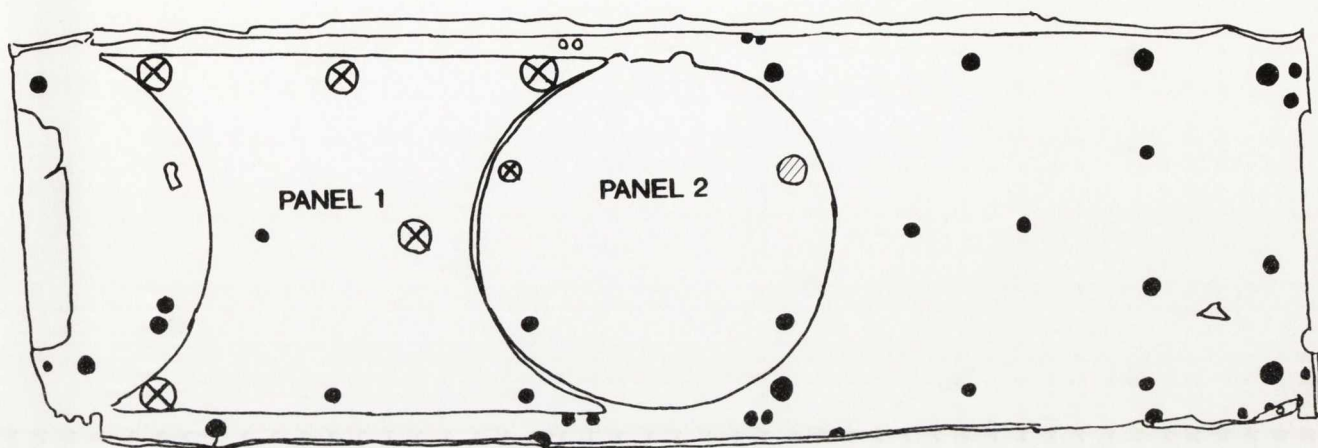
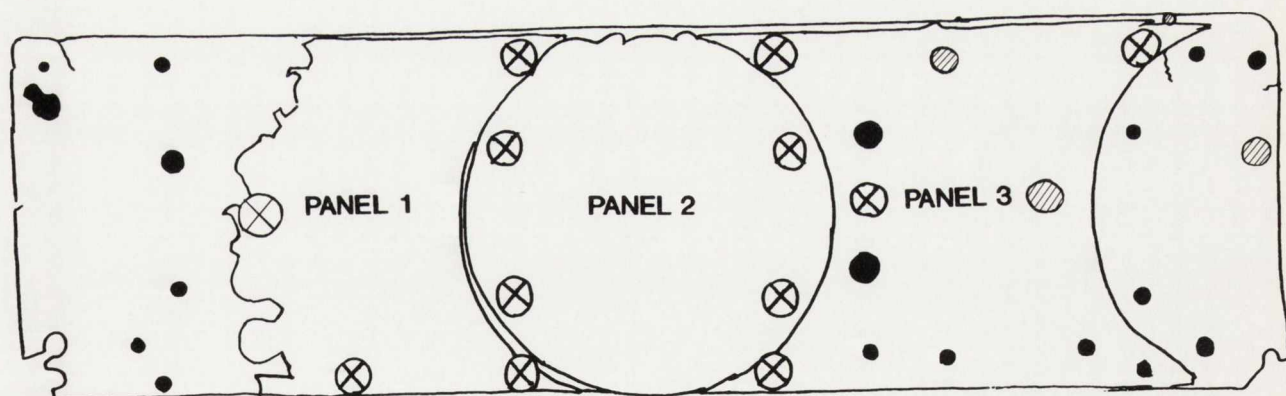


Fig. 6: Shrine of the Stowe Missal, Base.

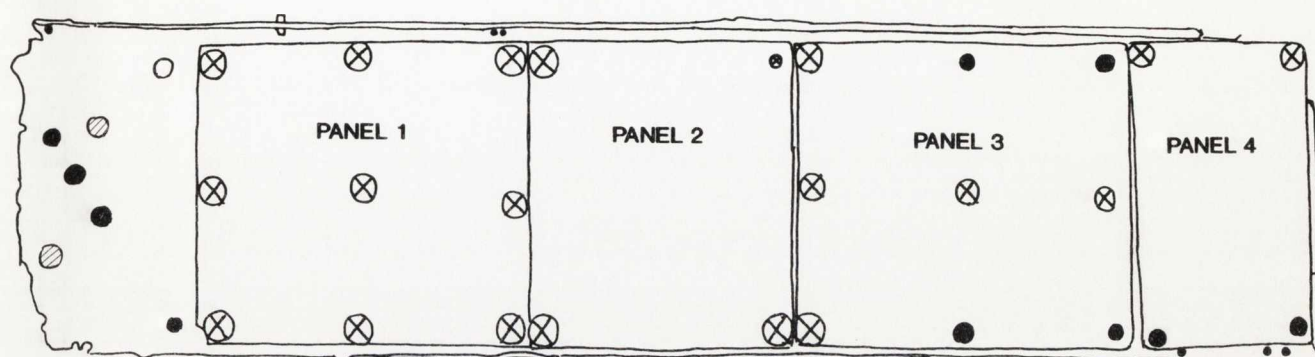

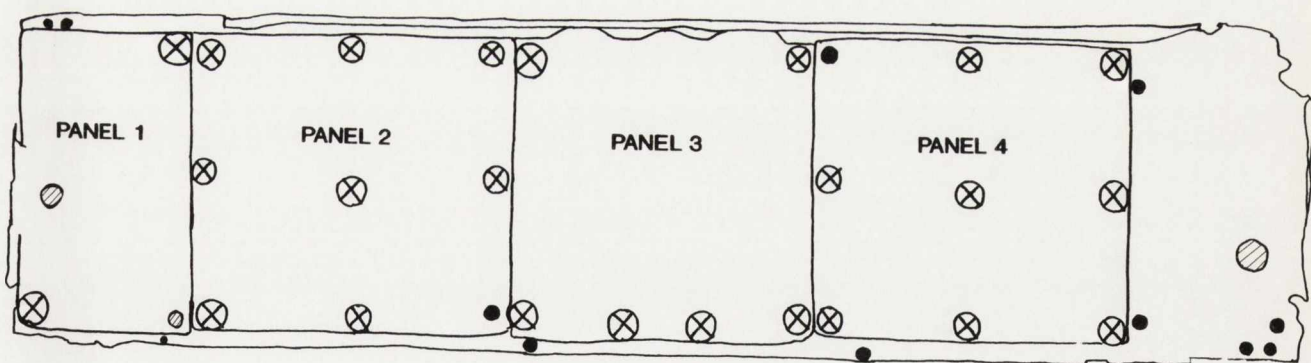

Fig. 8: Shrine of the Stowe Missal, Long Sides A and B.

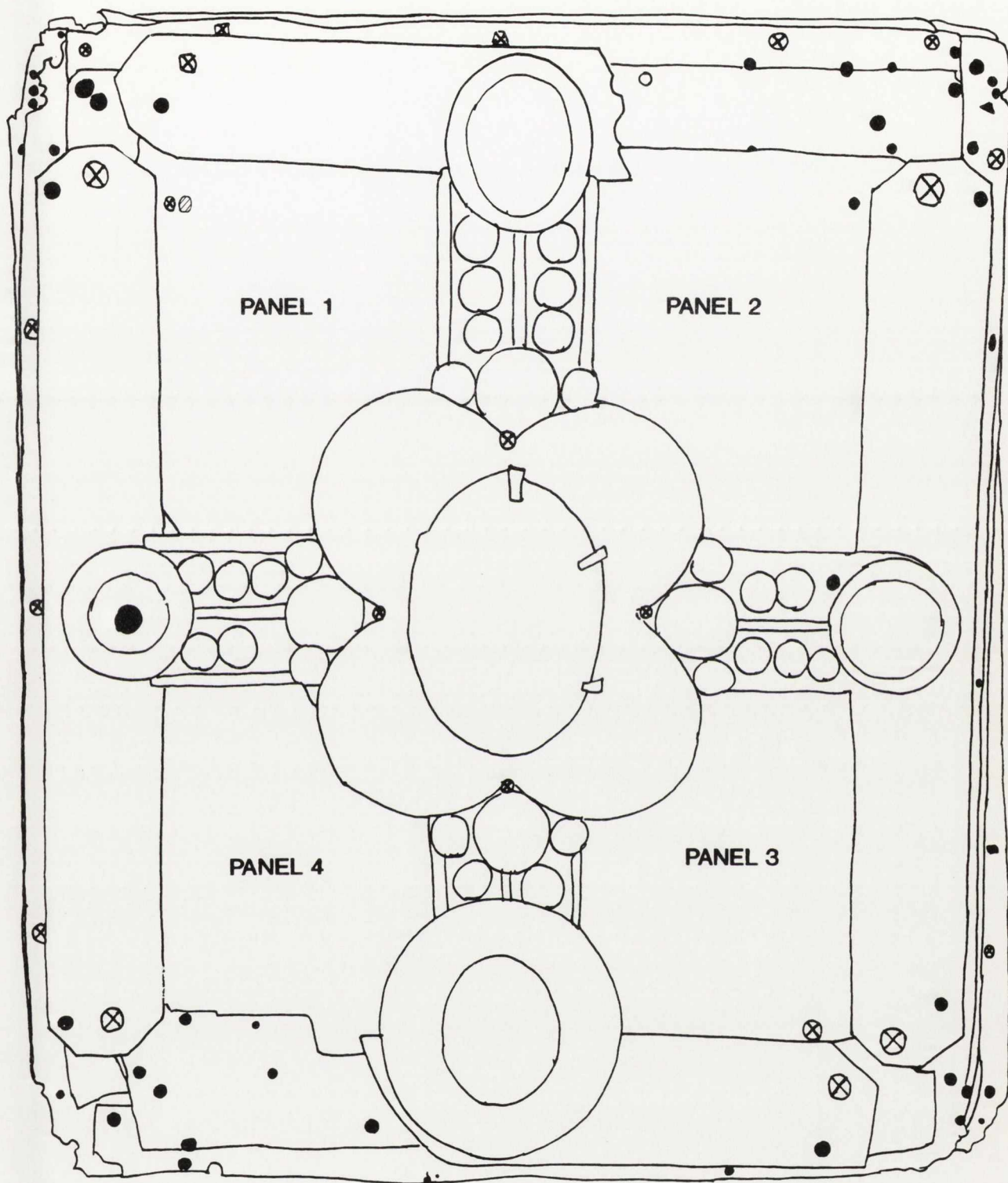
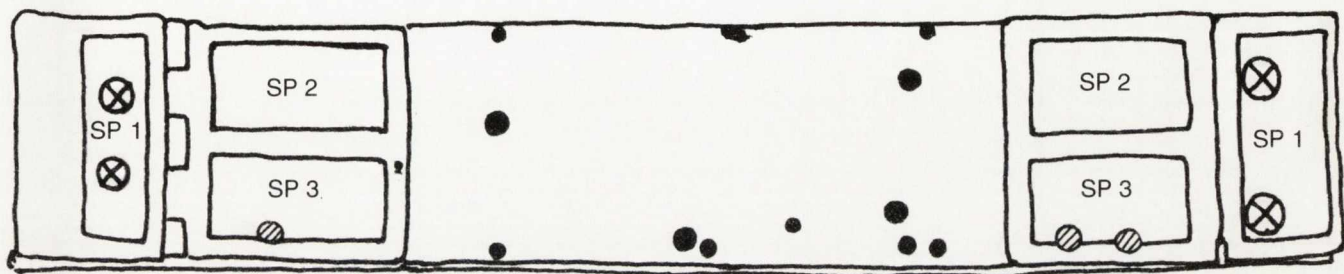


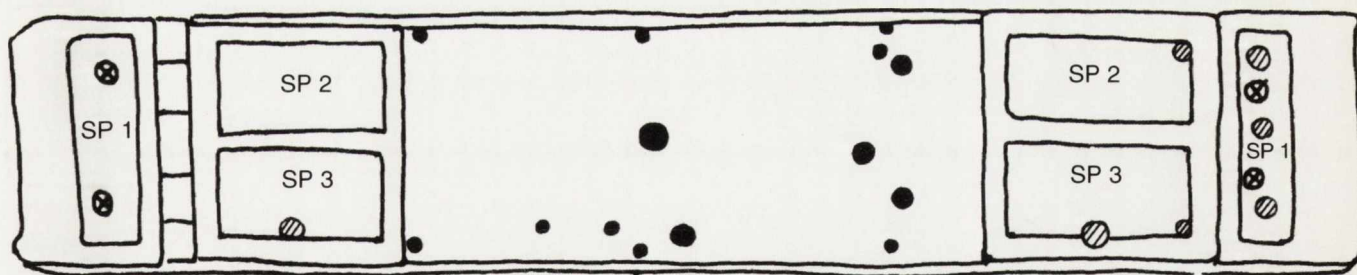
Fig. 9: Shrine of the Stowe Missal, Front.

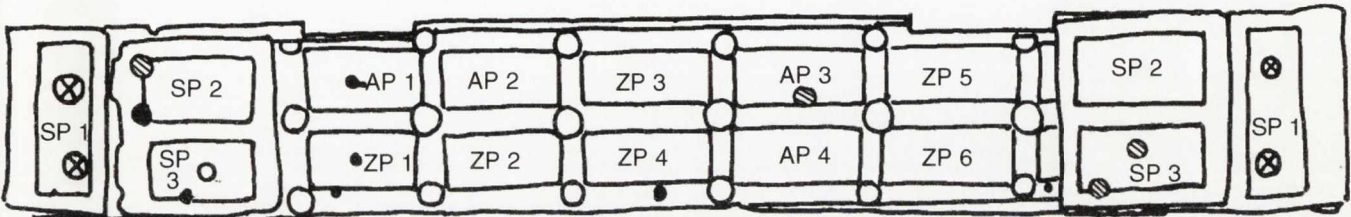

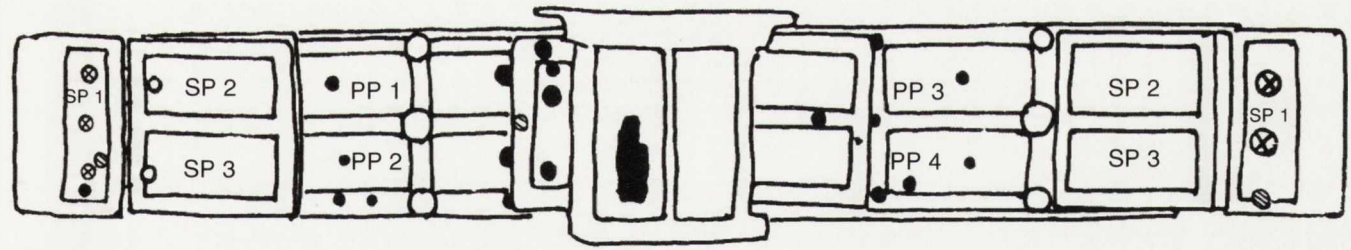
Fig 10: Shrine of the Cathach, Short Sides A and B.

Fig 11: Shrine of the Cathach, Long Sides A and B.

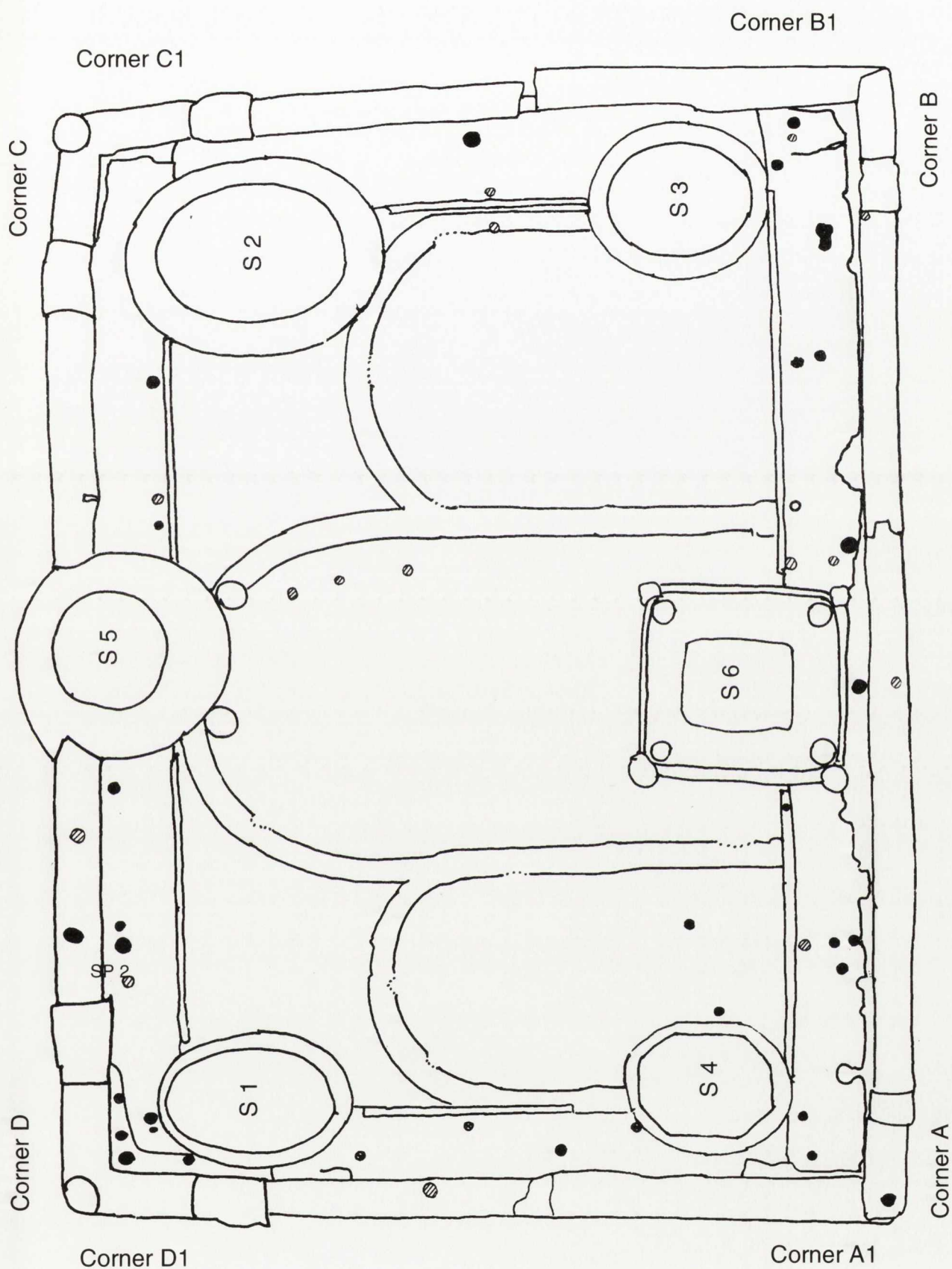


Fig 12: Shrine of the Cathach, Front.

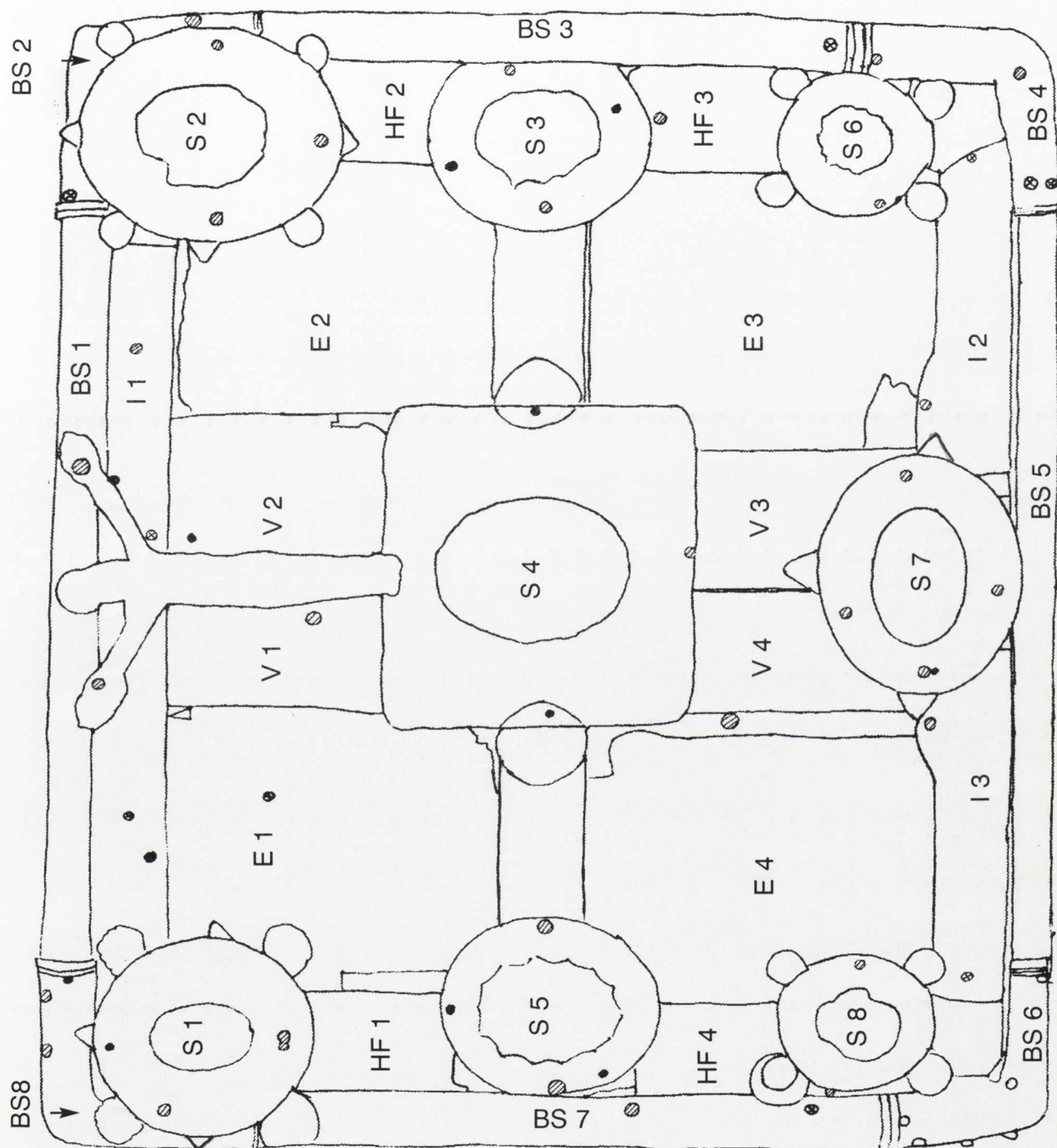


Fig 13: The Misach, Front.

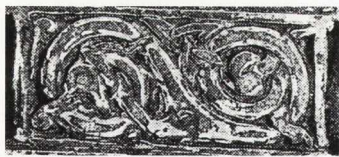

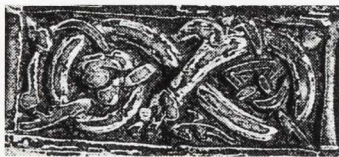

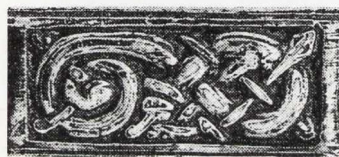
Fig. 14: Soisceál Molaisse, animal ornament, Types 1-2.

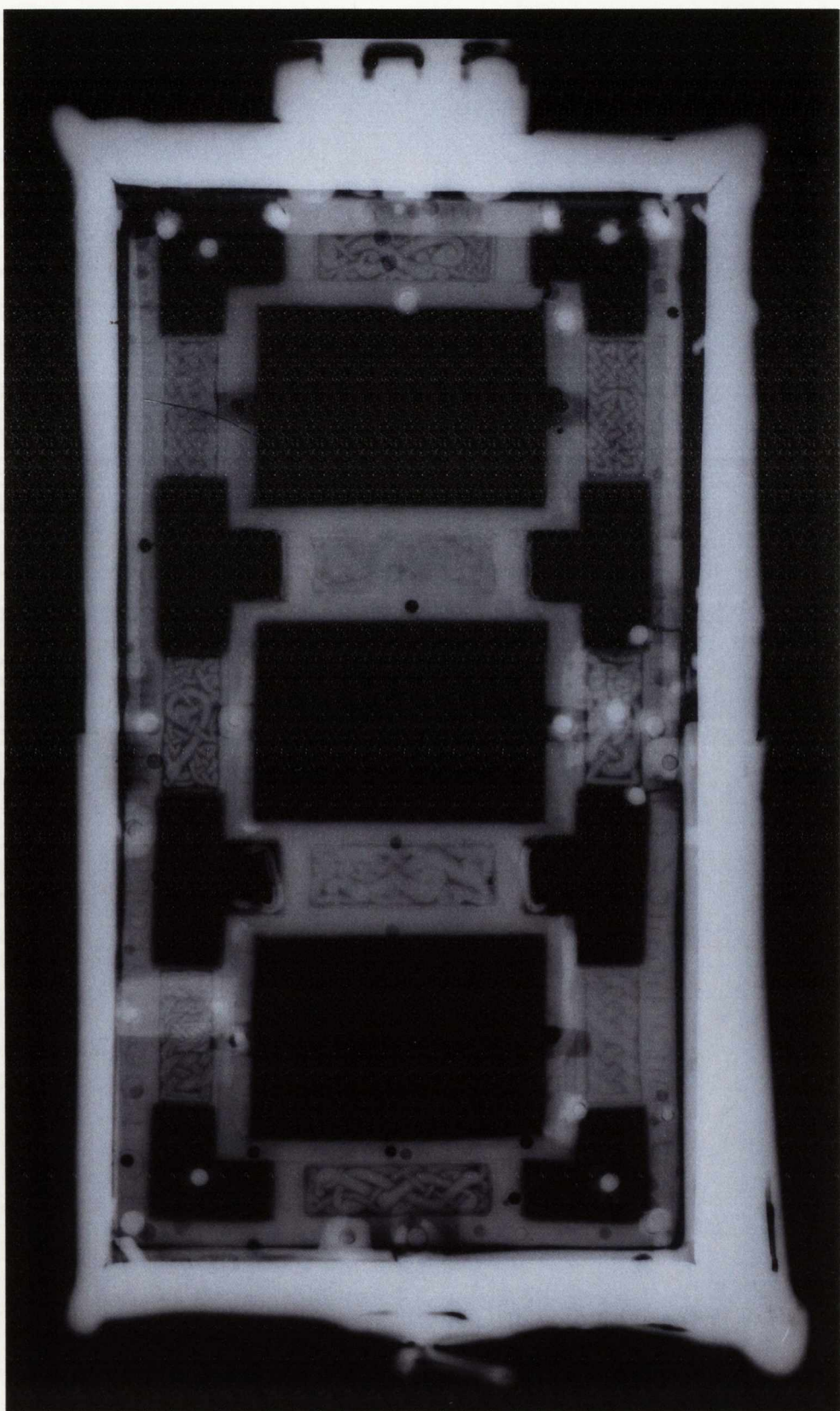
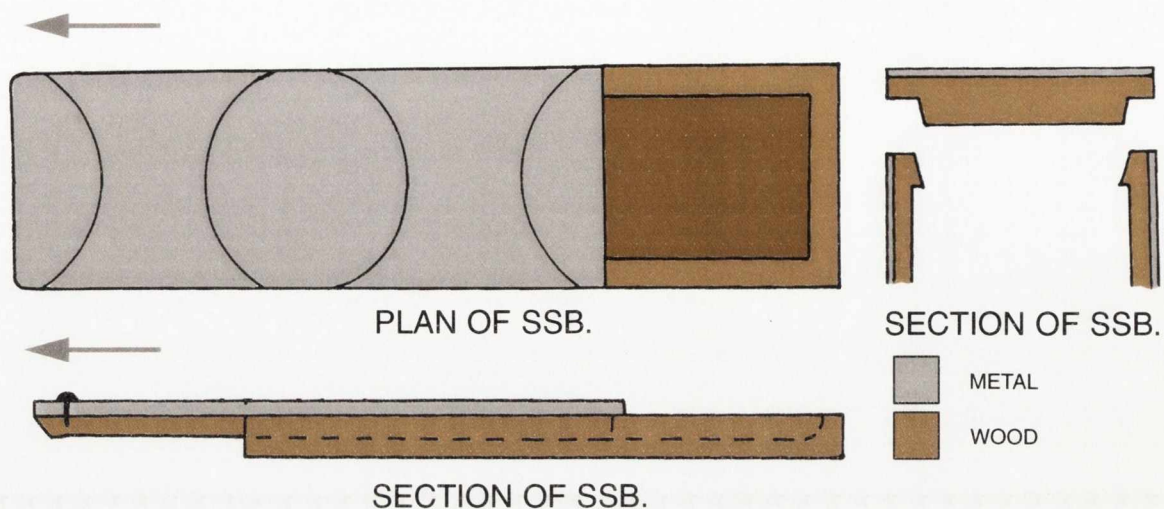
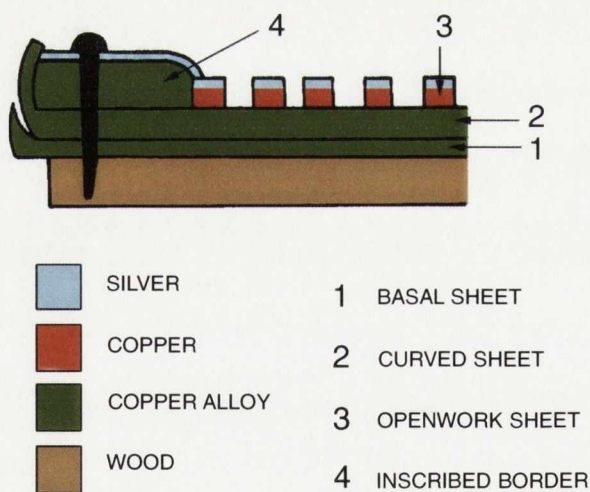


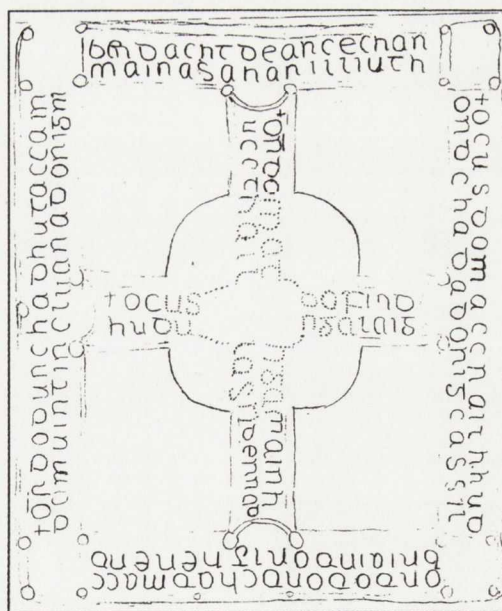
Fig. 16: Soisceál Molaisse, radiograph of Long Side.

Fig 18: Shrine of the Cathach. Radiograph of SSA with sketch of zoomorphic ornament.

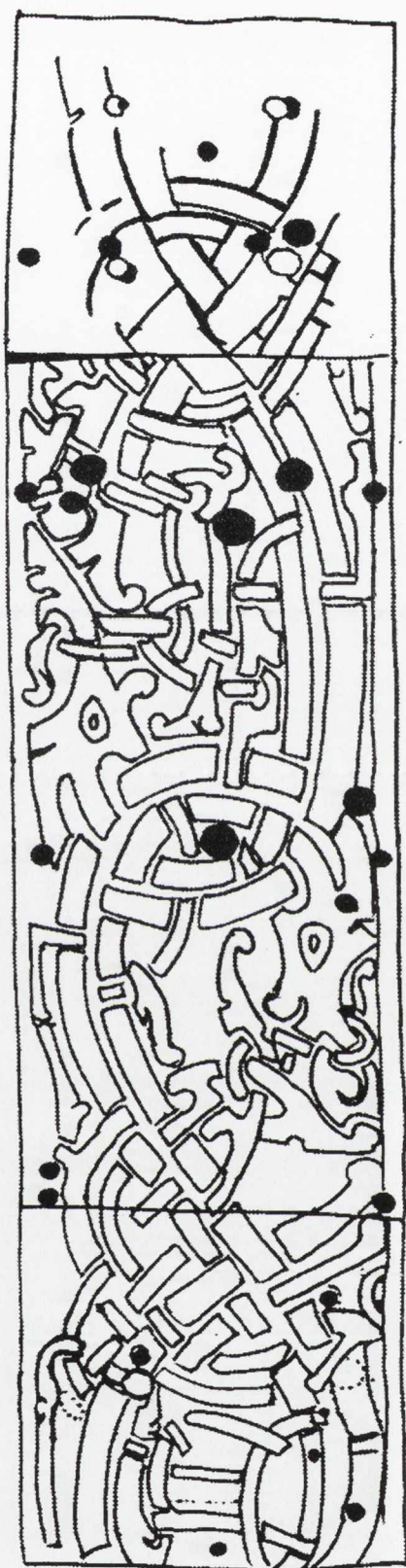
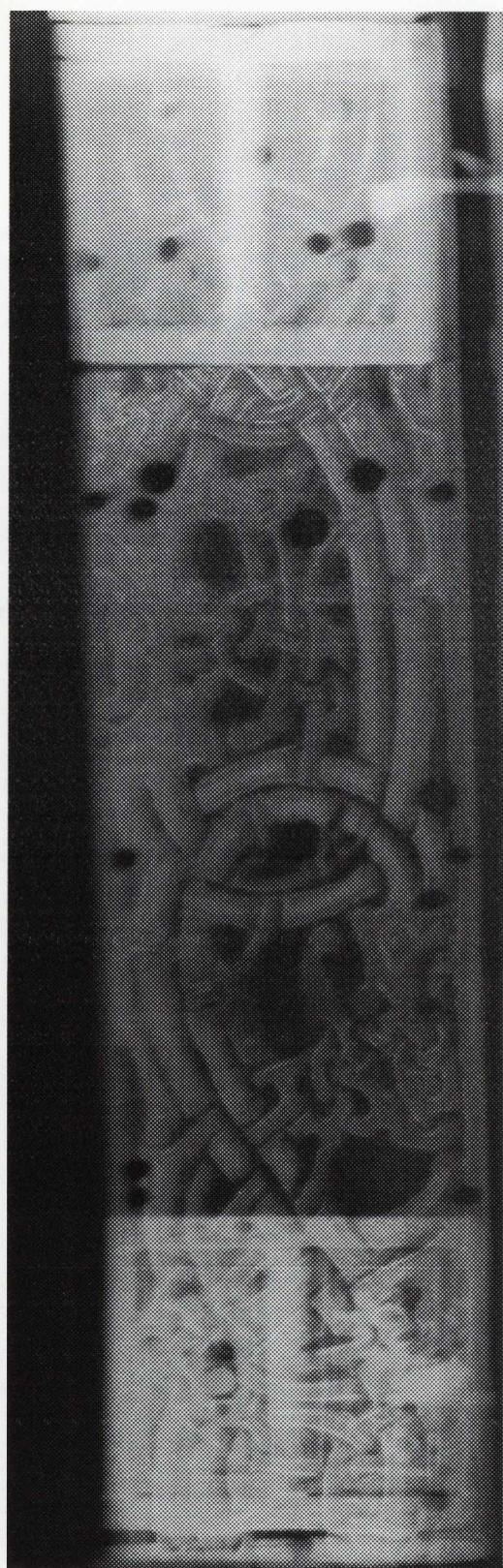


Fig 19: Shrine of the Cathach. Radiograph of SSB with sketch of zoomorphic ornament.

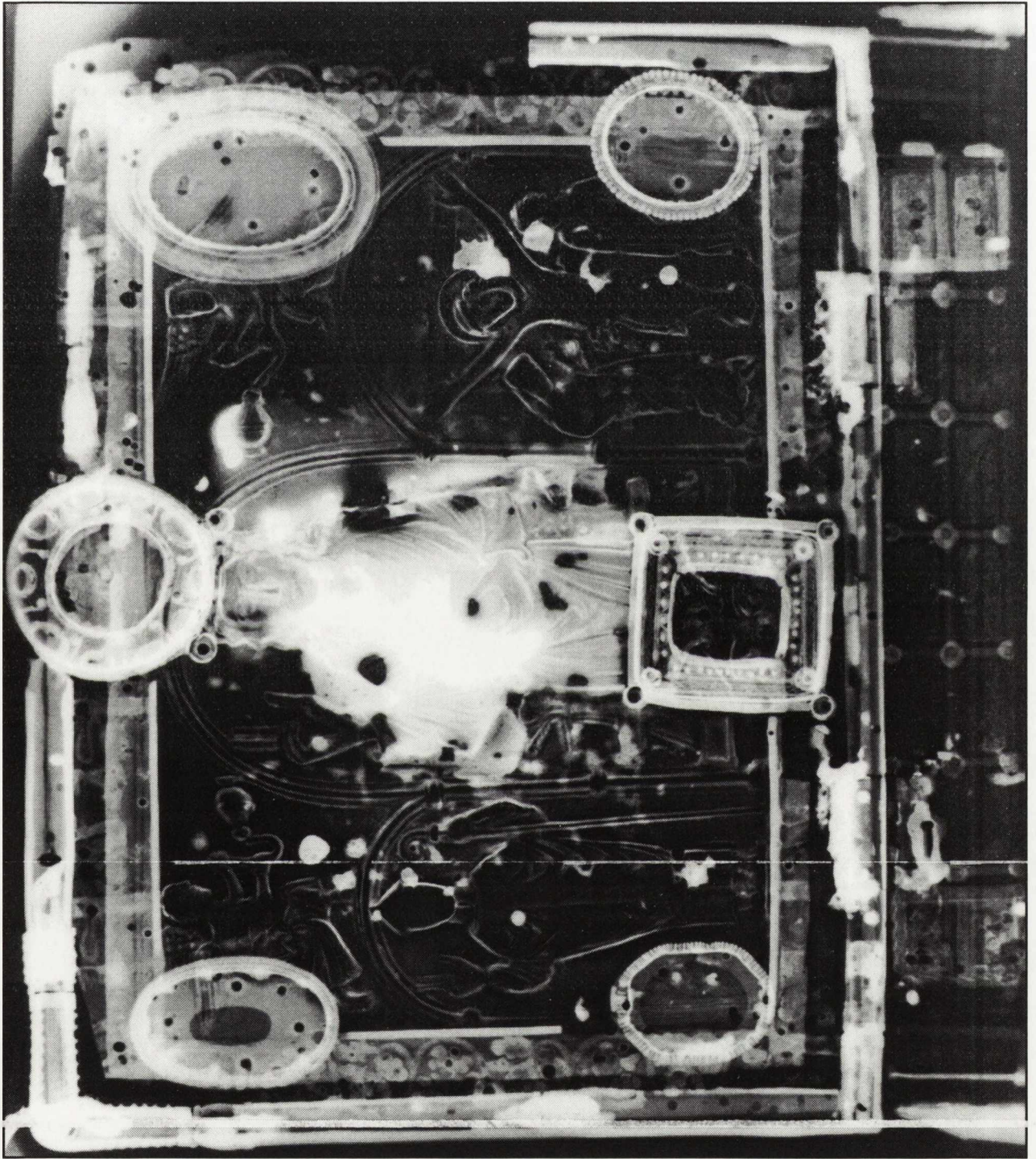
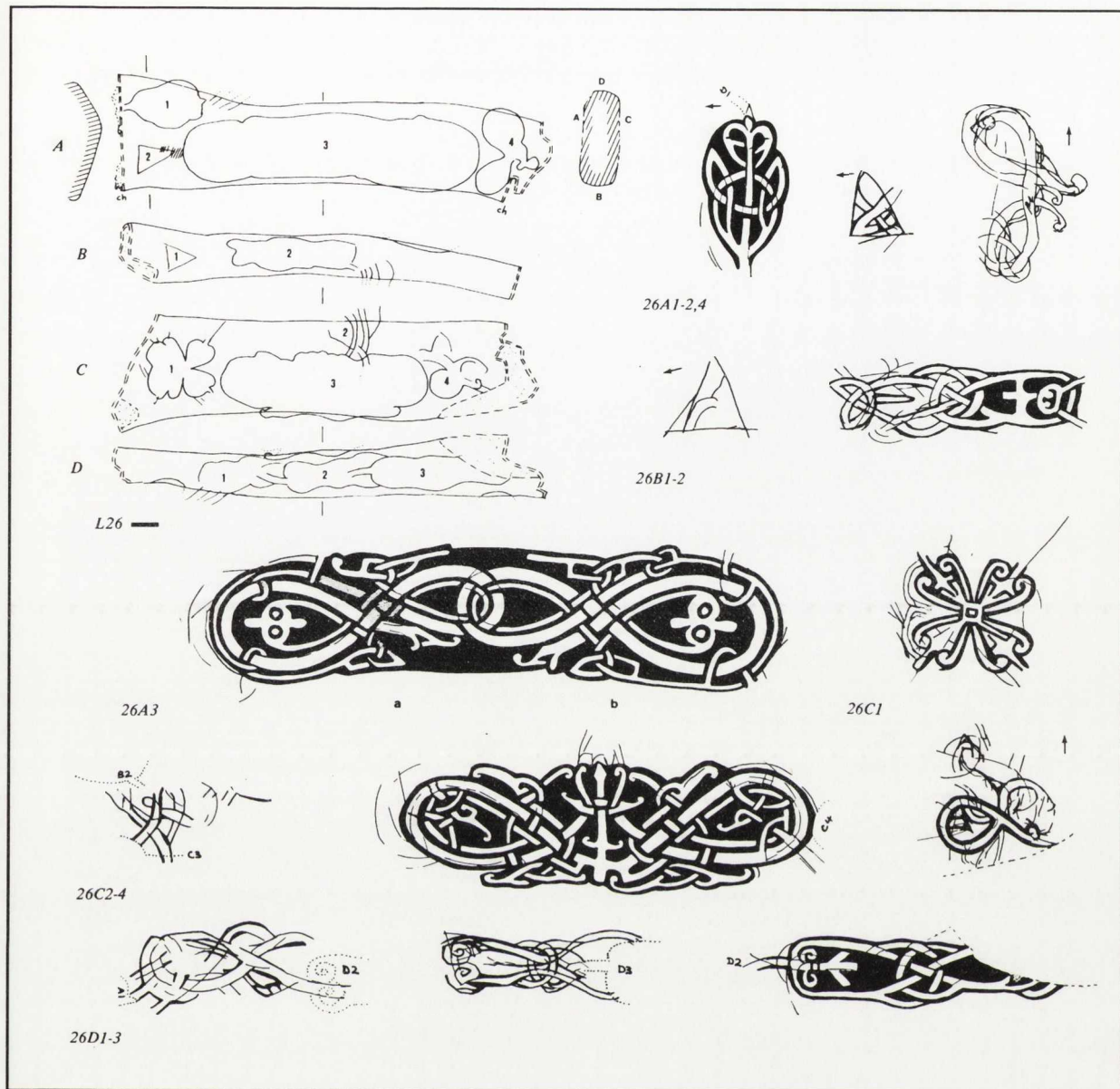


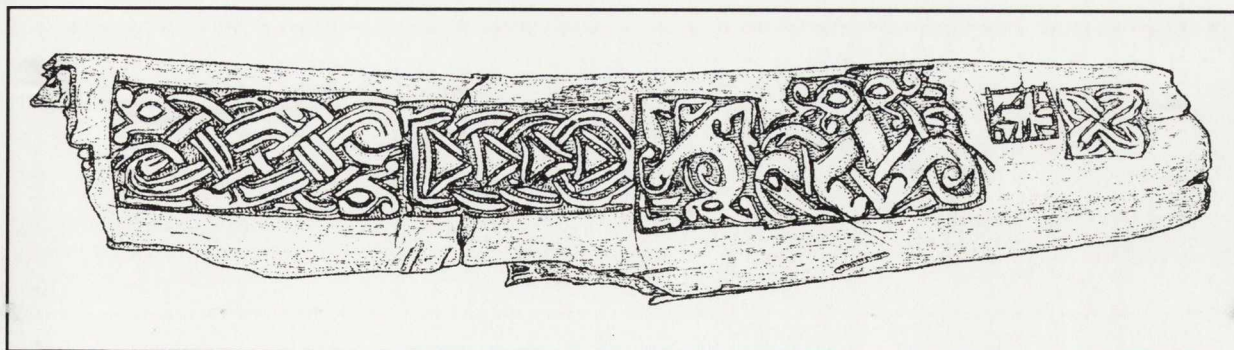
Fig 20: Shrine of the Cathach. Radiograph of front



Fig 21: The Misach. Sketch of zoomorphic ornament

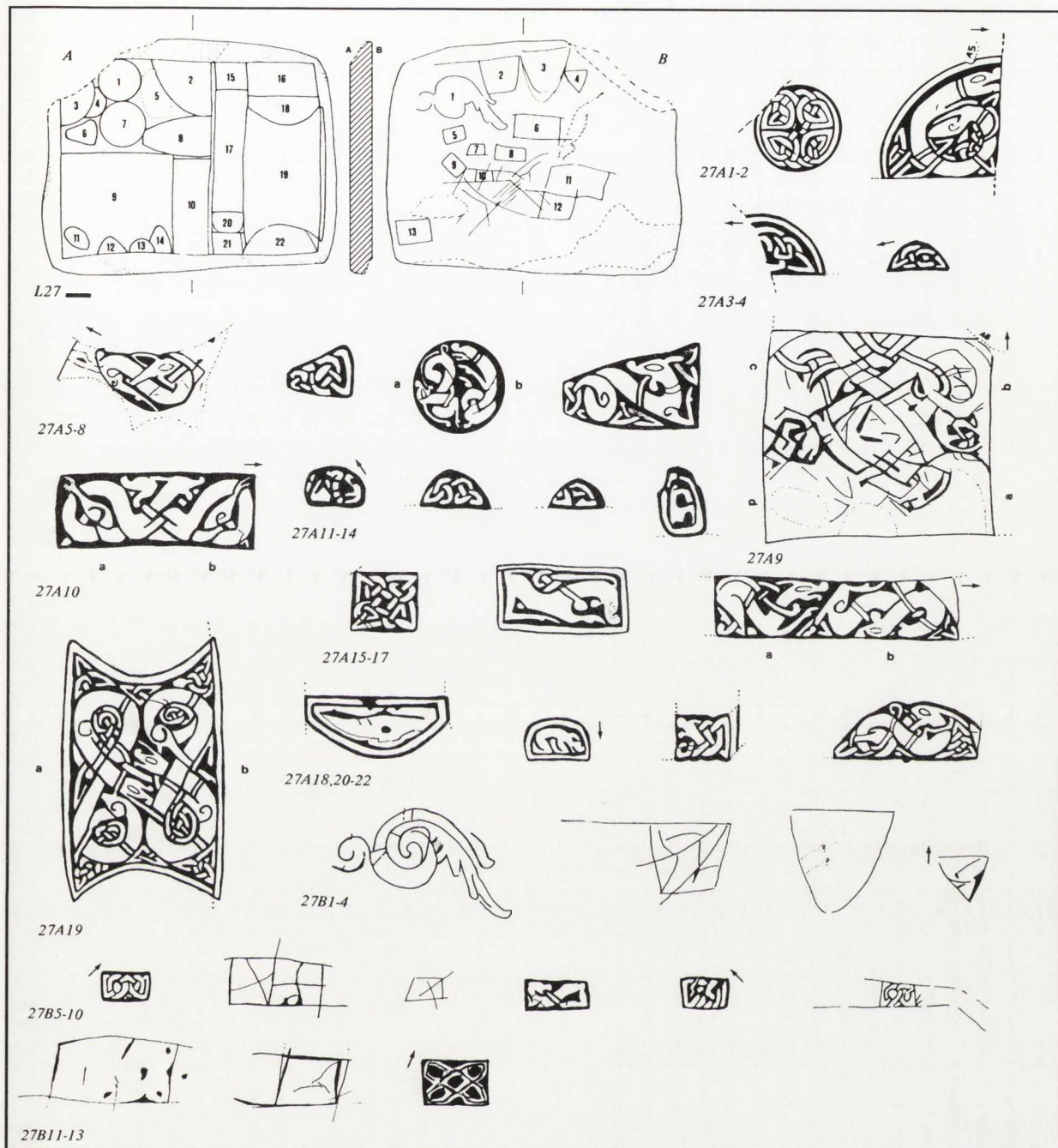

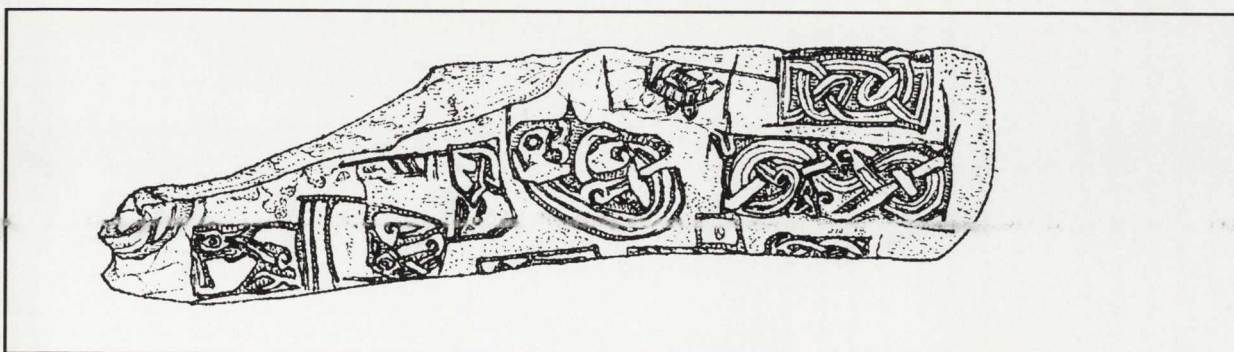

a. E122:8760 (after O' Meadhra 1979). **b.** E122:16264.

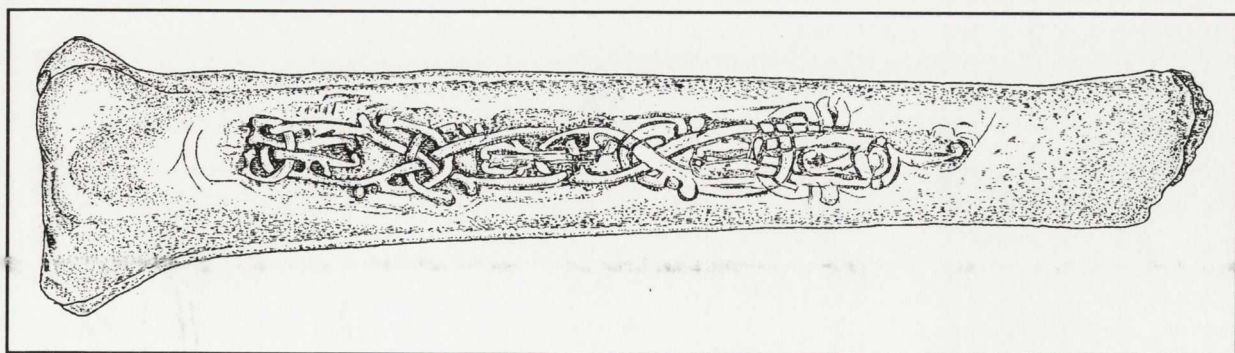
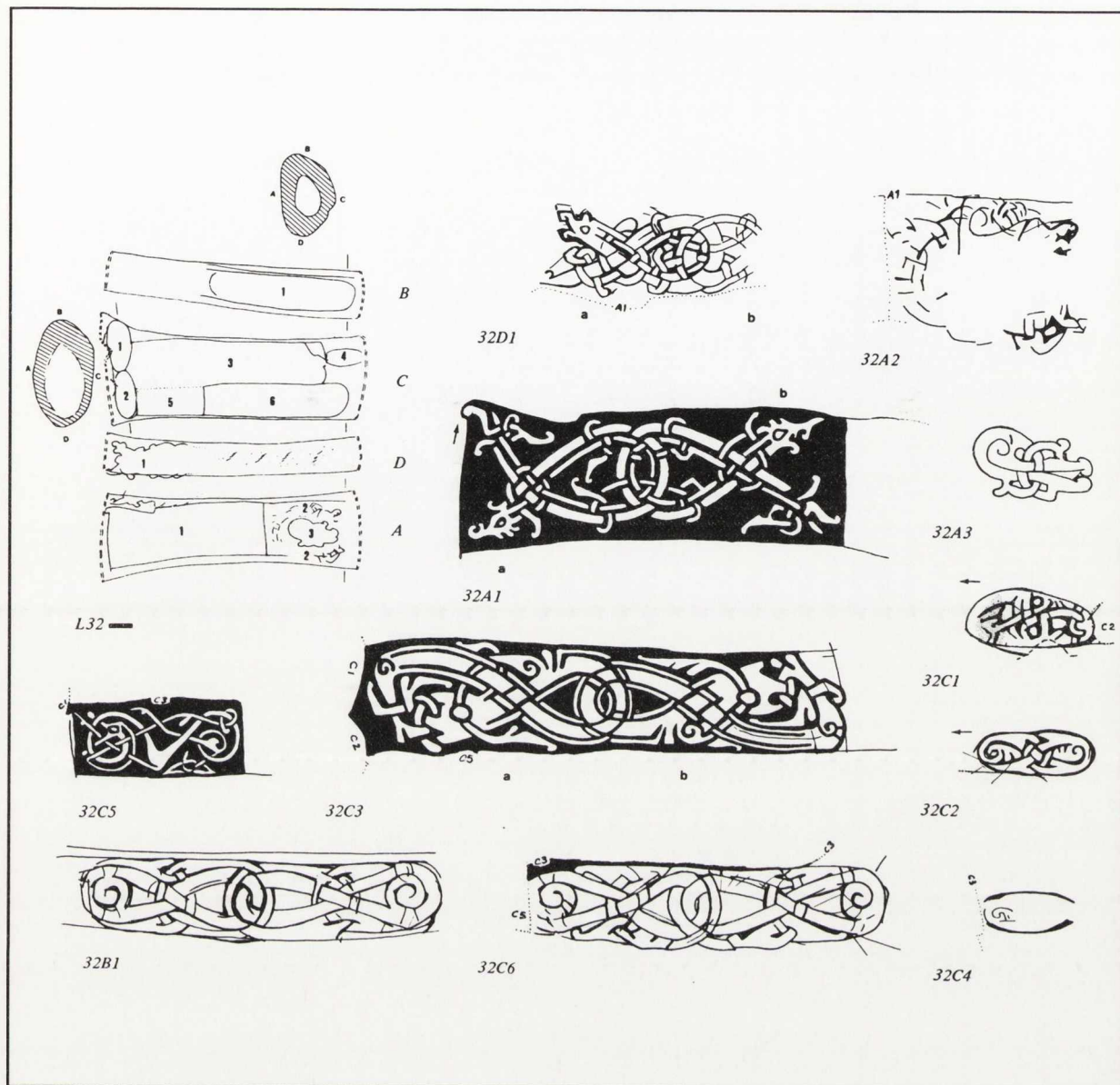
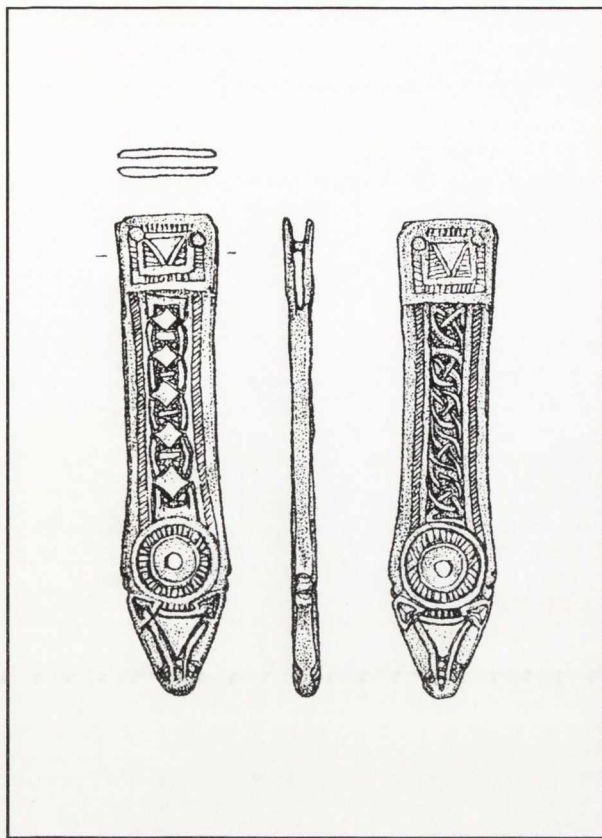


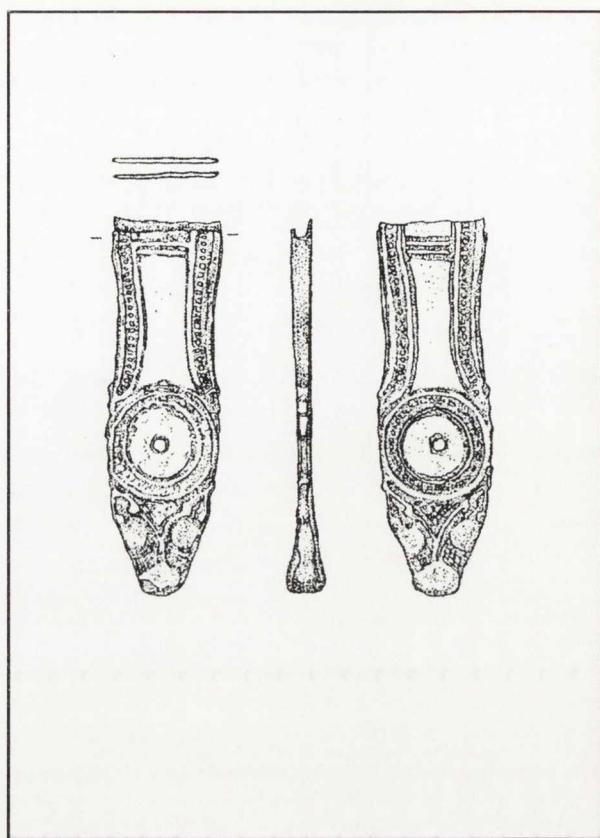
Fig. 24: Motif-pieces.

a. High Street, Dublin, E71:708 (after O' Meadhra 1979).

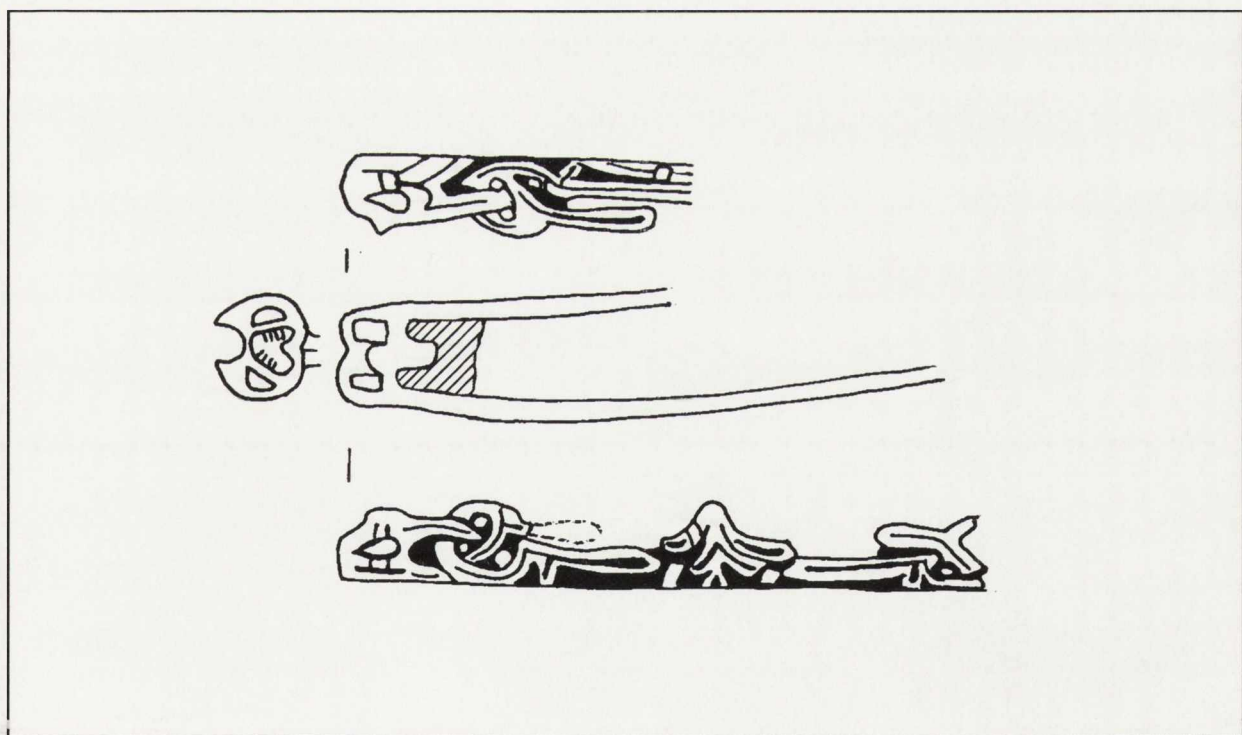
