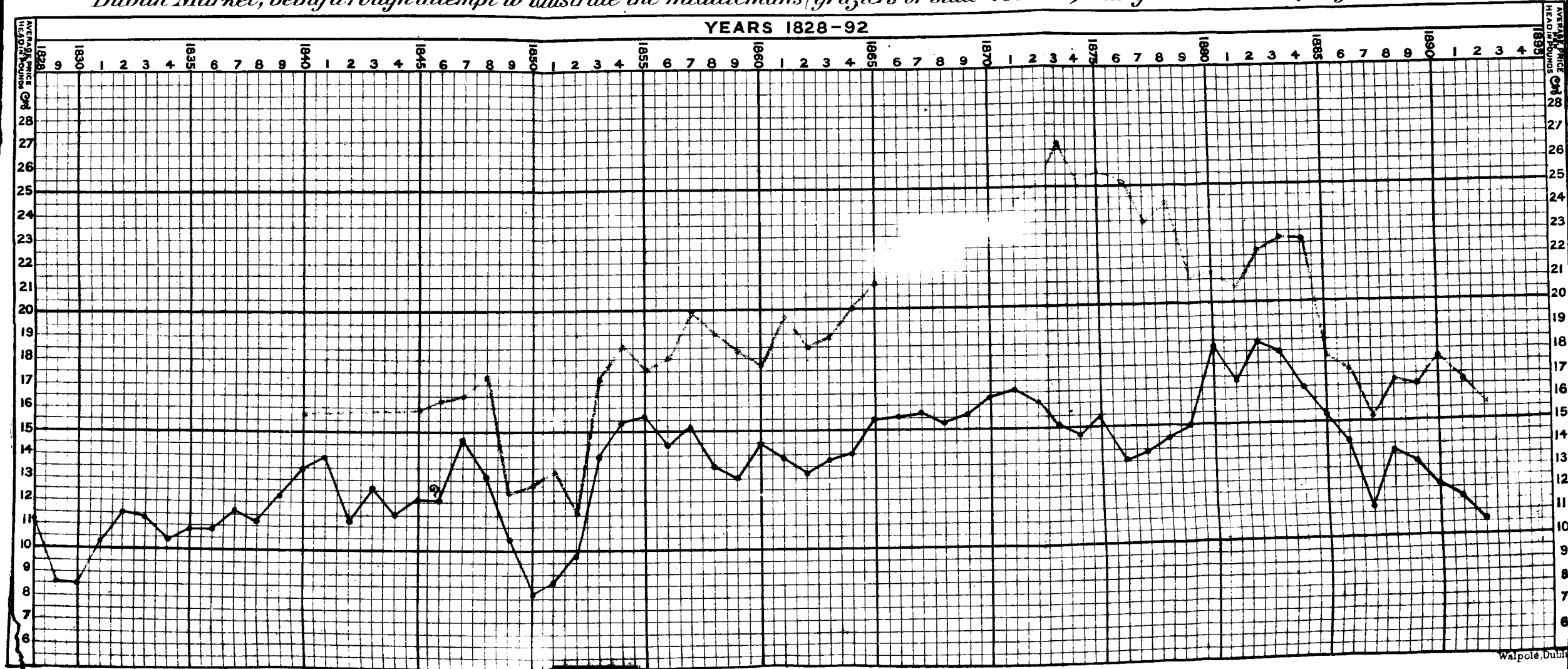

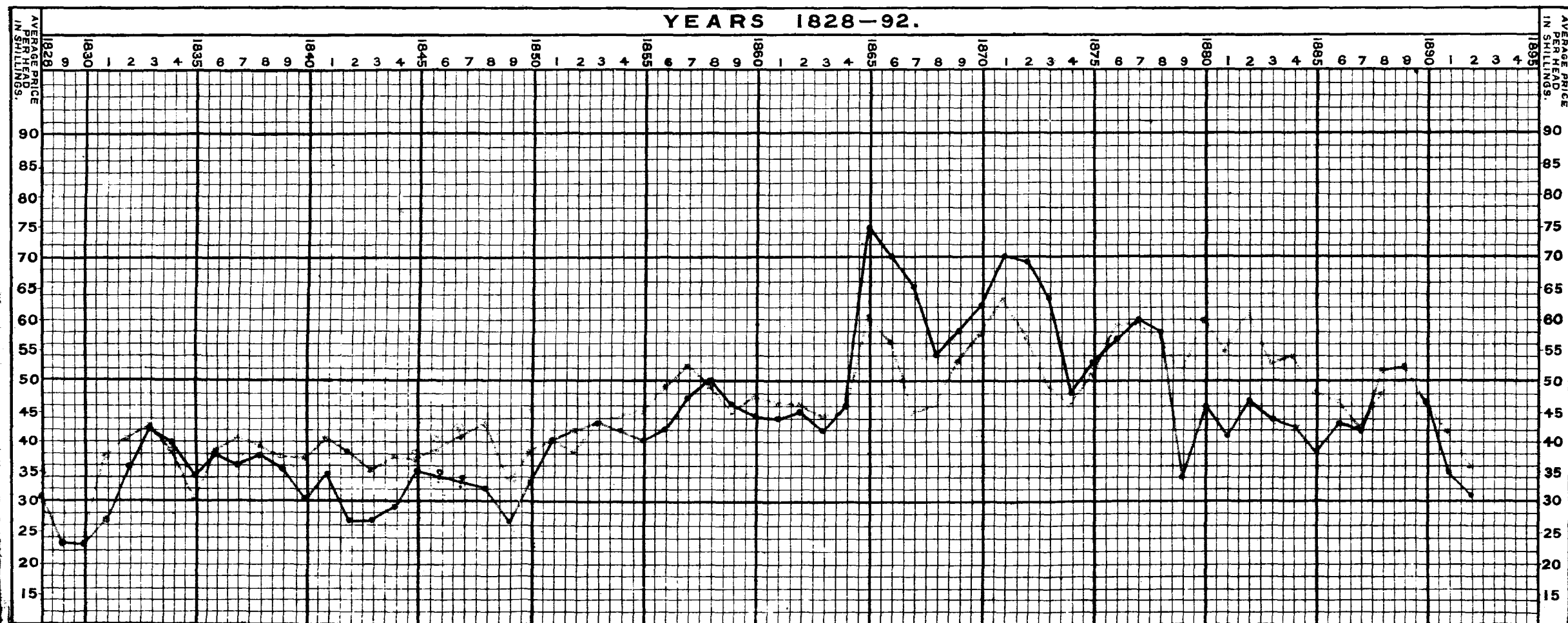

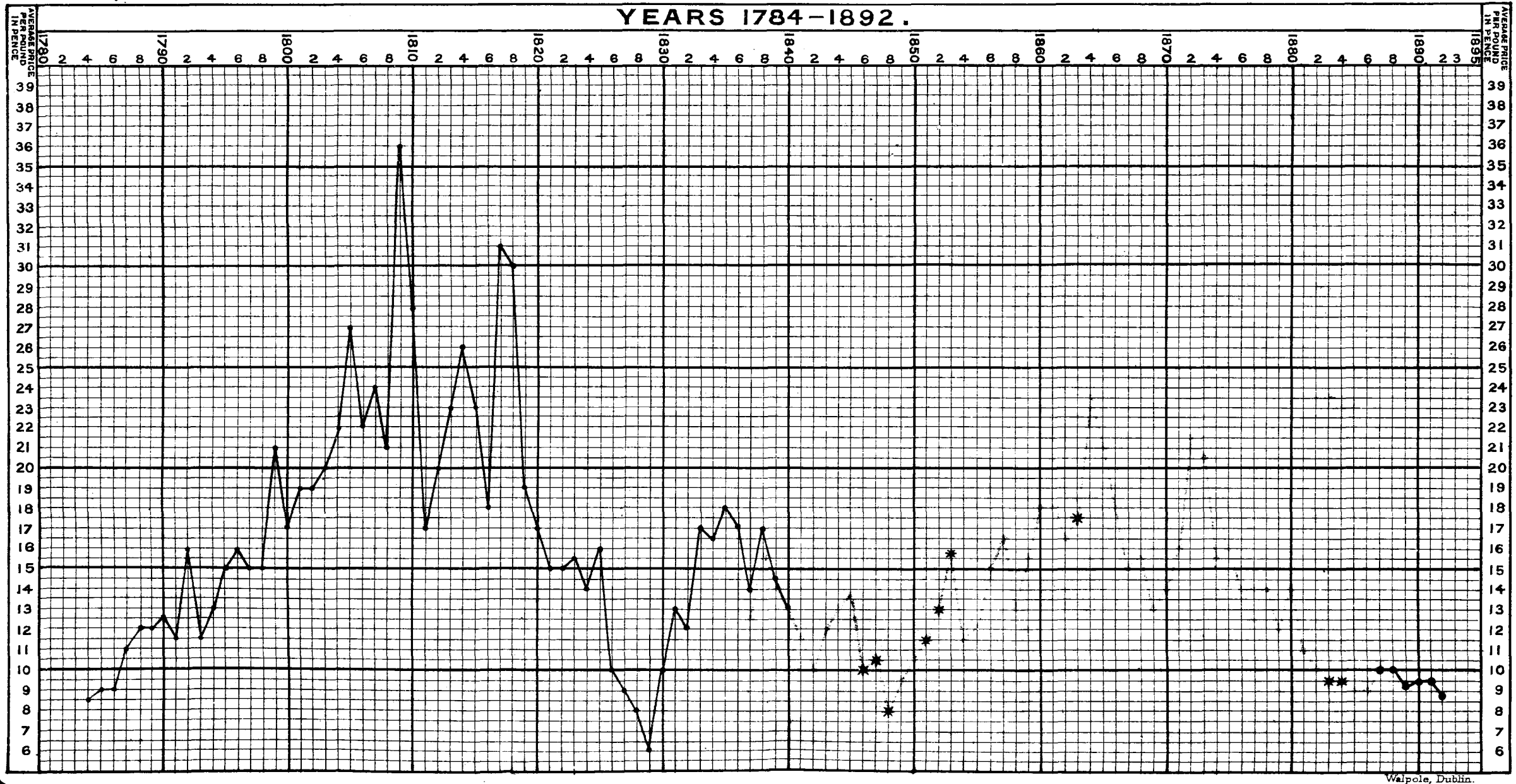

Showing the average price as obtained from different sources of British Wool from the years 1784 to 1892 (109 years) both years inclusive.

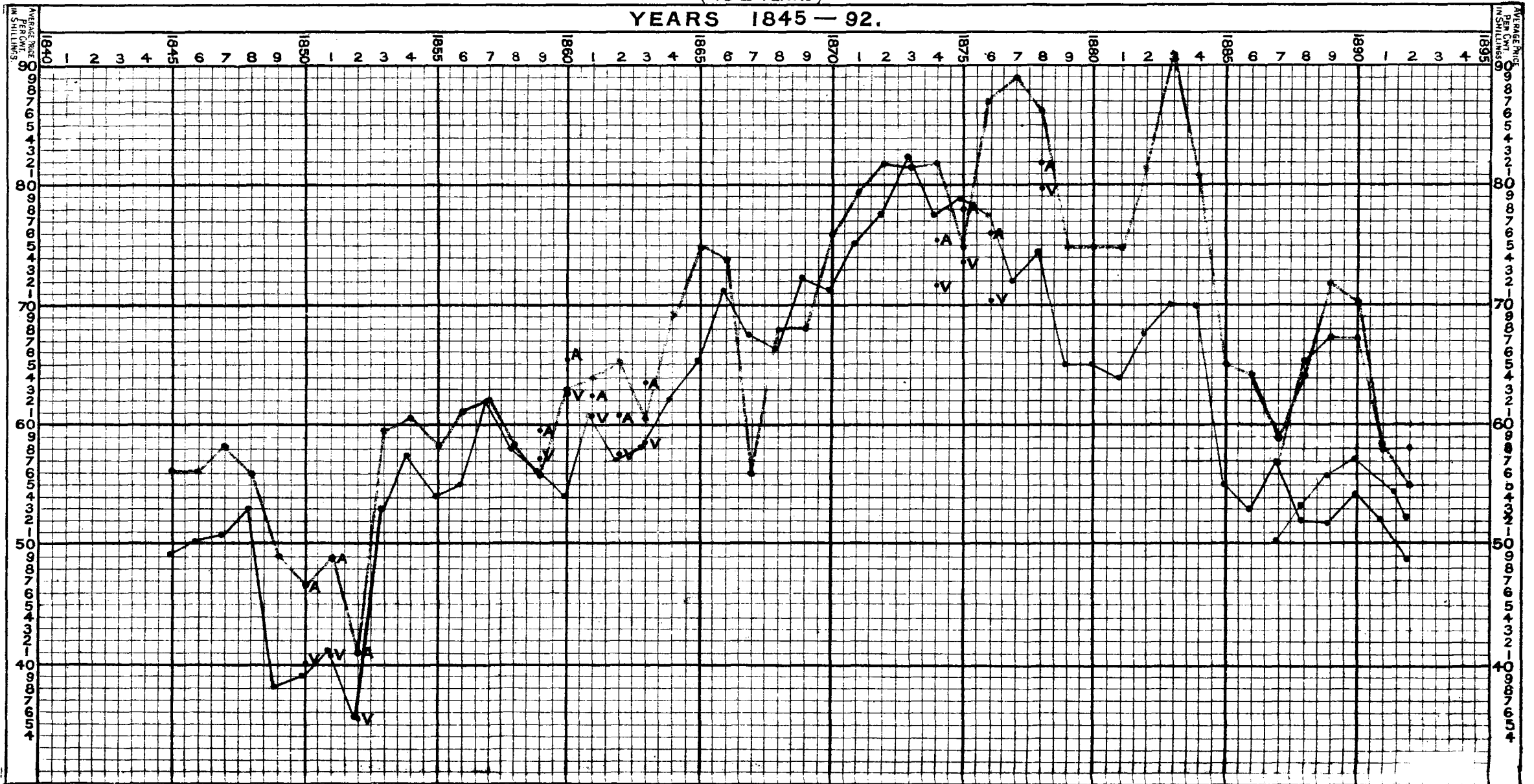

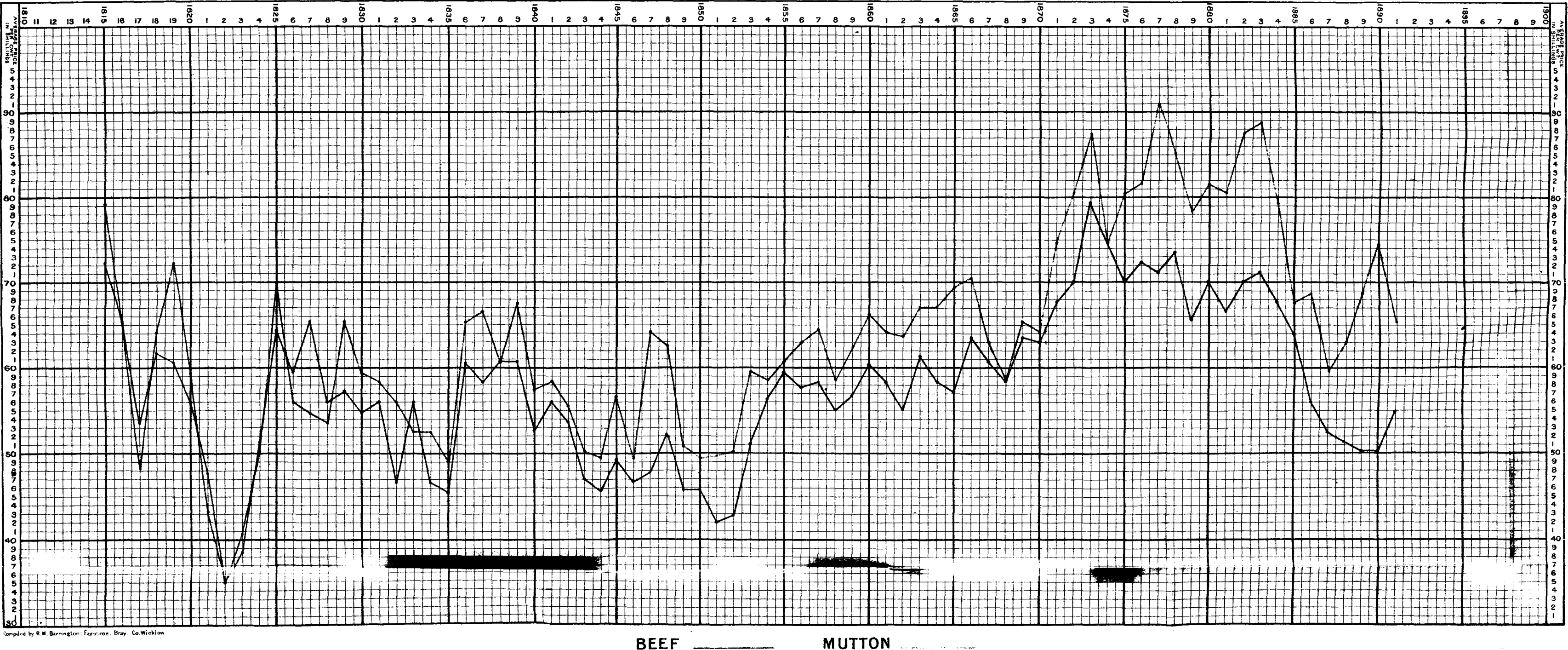

DIAGRAM N^o 5. BEEF & MUTTON.

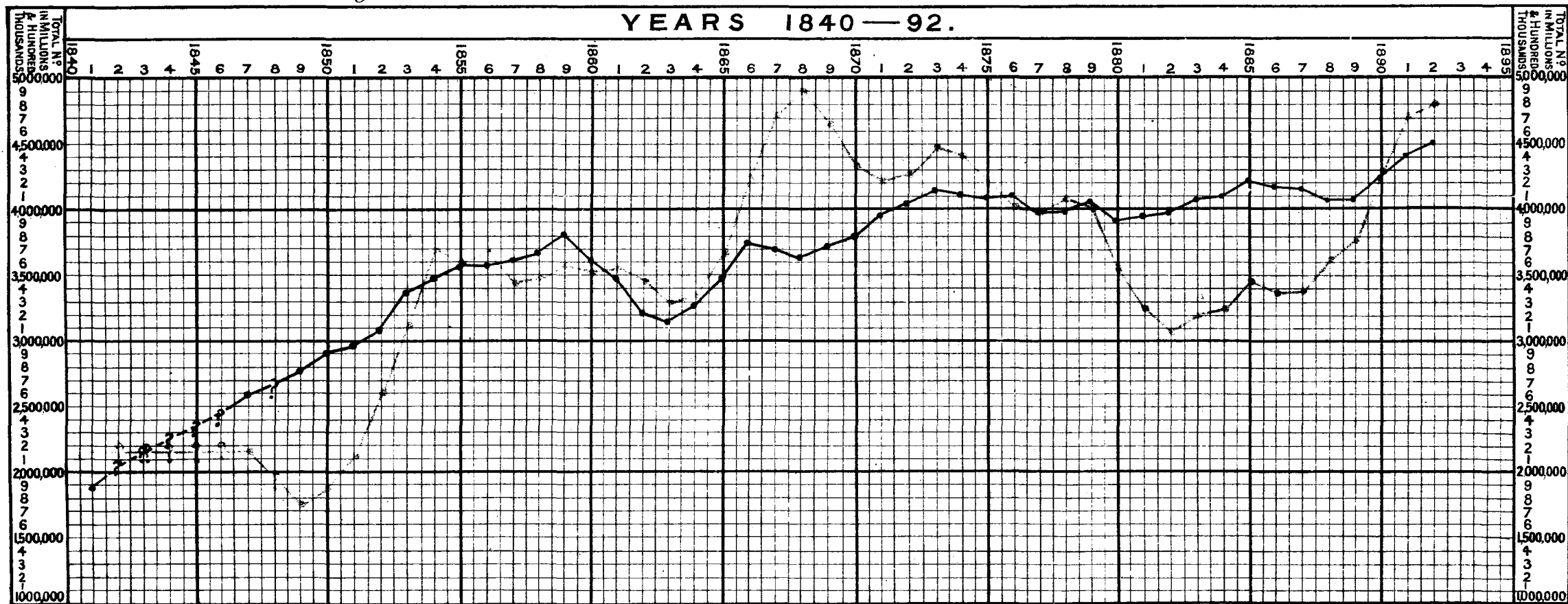
Showing the average price per Cwt. of Beef & Mutton in the London Metropolitan Cattle Market since 1815.

Showing the Number of Sheep & Cattle in Ireland since the Year 1841.



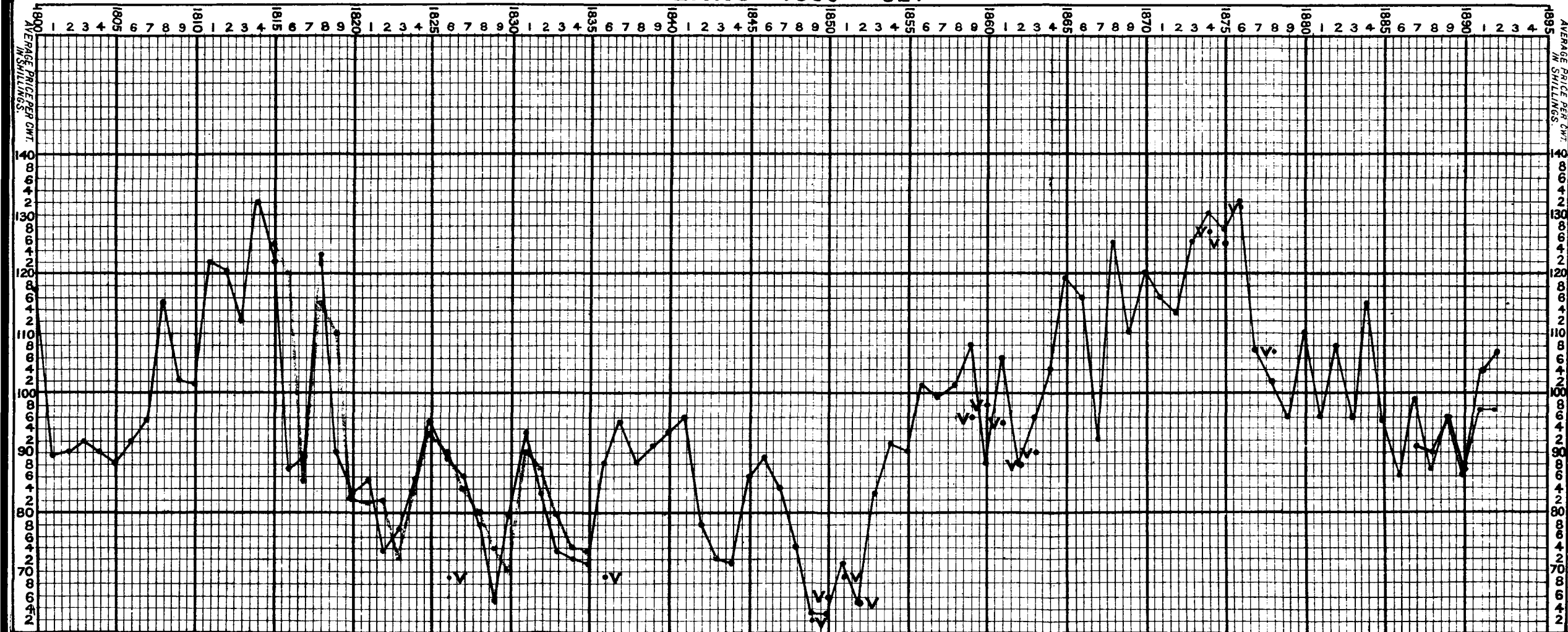

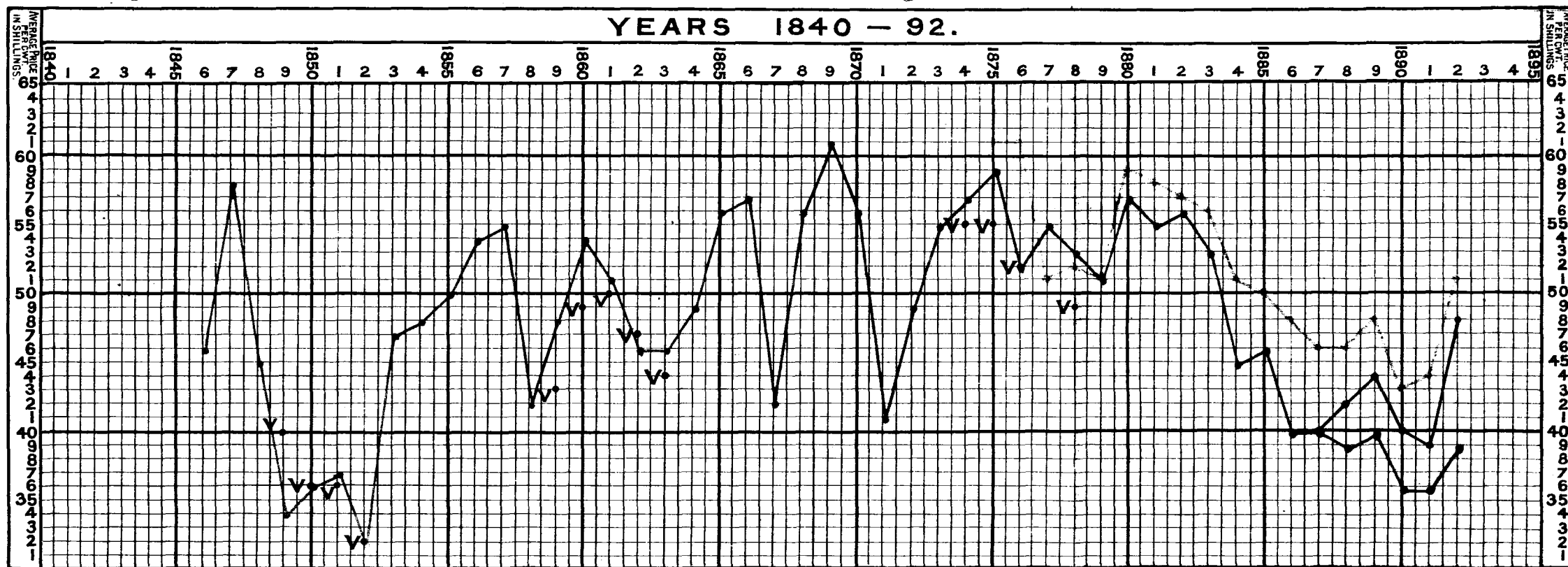

Showing the Average Price per cwt. for Pork in Shillings from the Year 1846 to 1892 both inclusive.



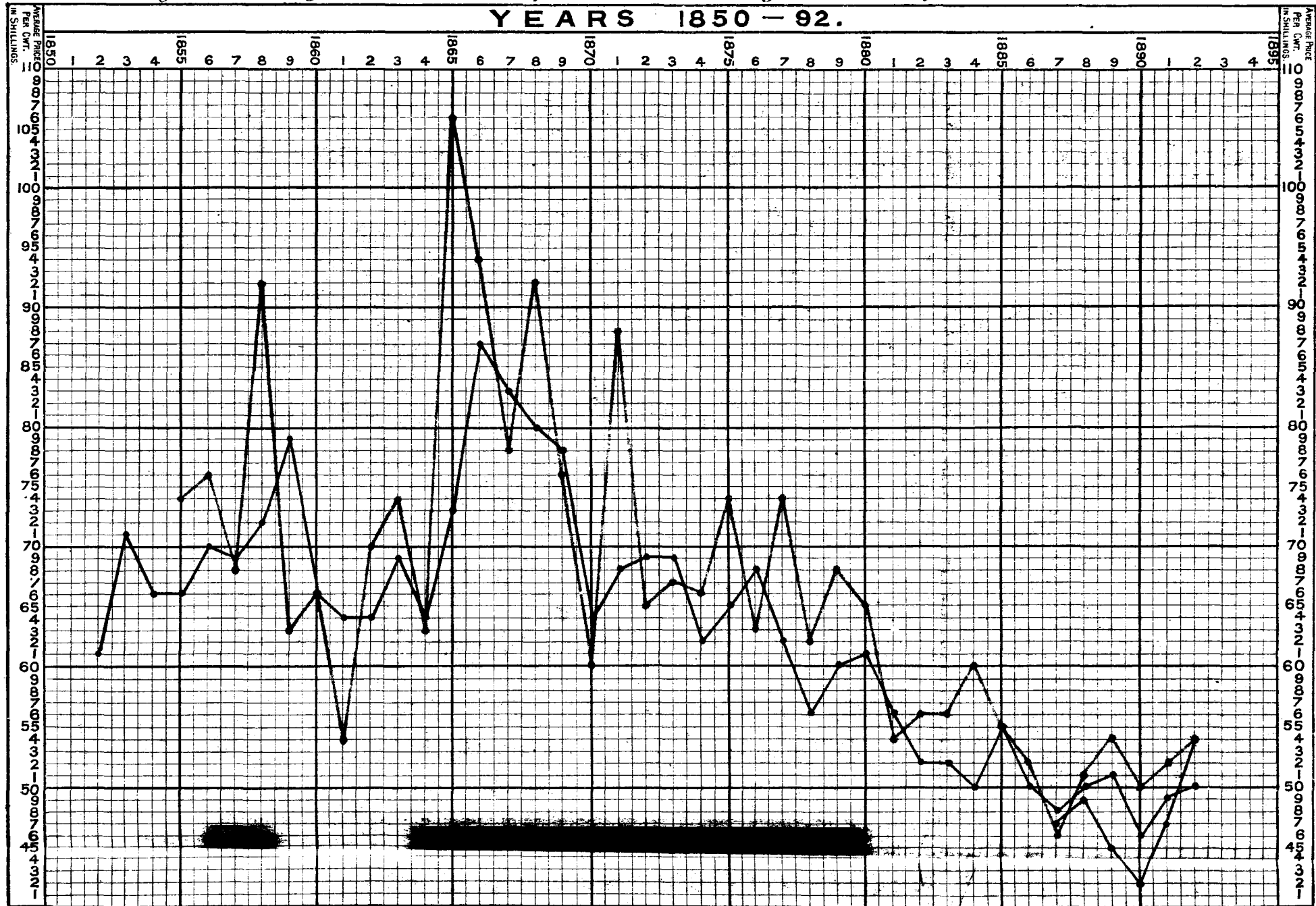

Showing the Average Price of Flax per cwt in Shillings from the year 1852 to 1892 both inclusive.

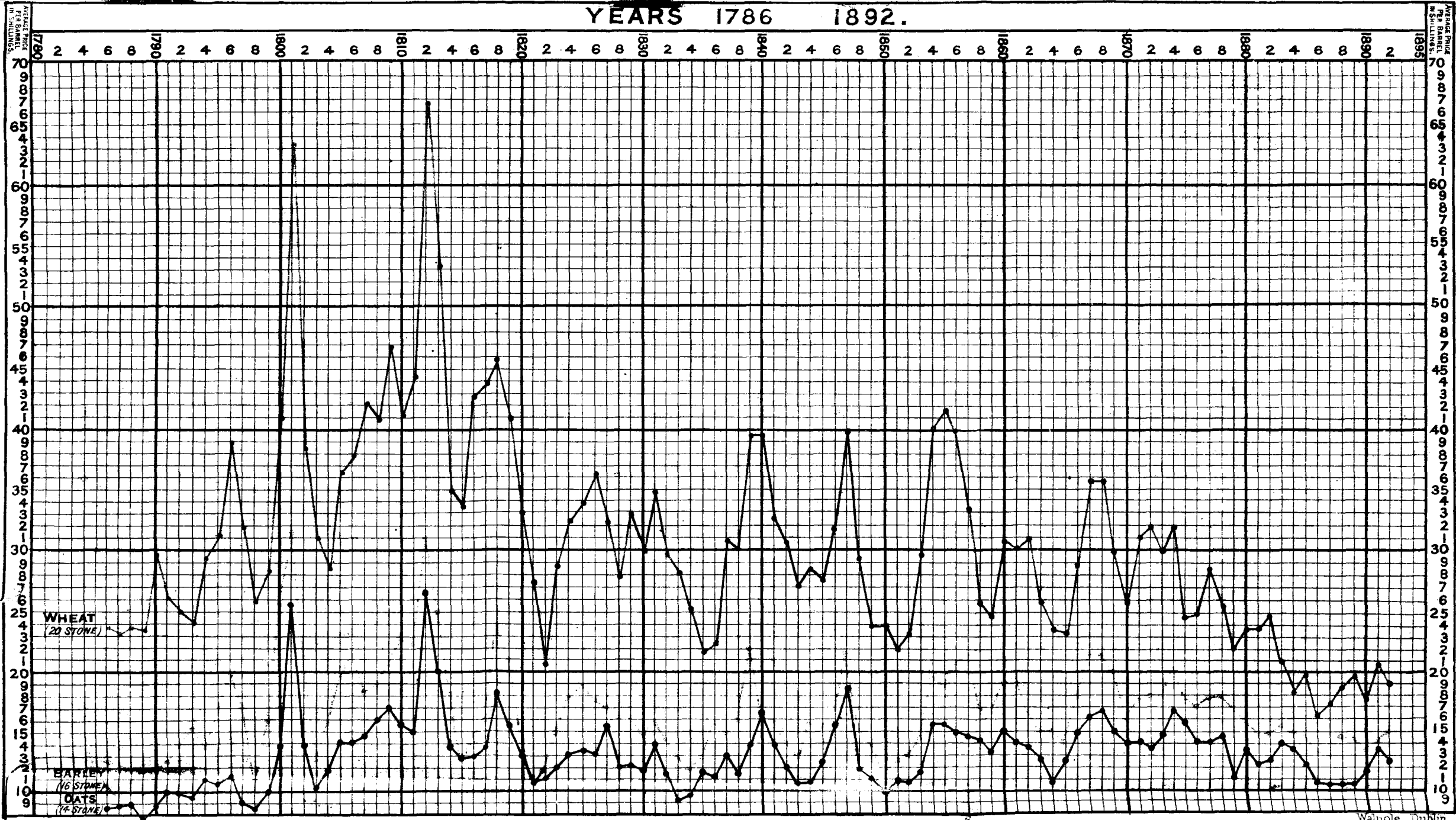

Showing the Average Prices of Wheat, Barley & Oats in Dublin Market for 106 Years 1786 to 1892.



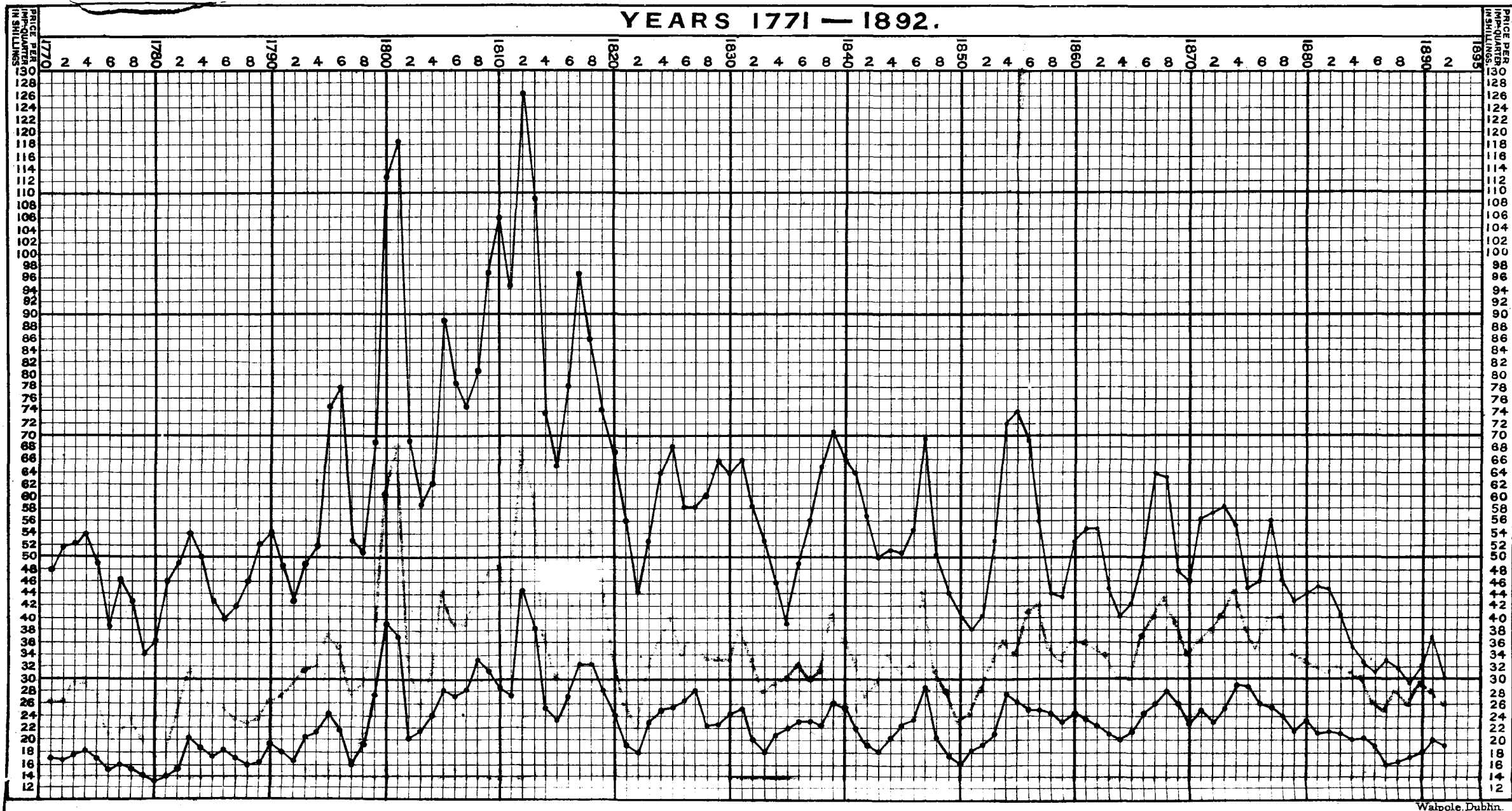
